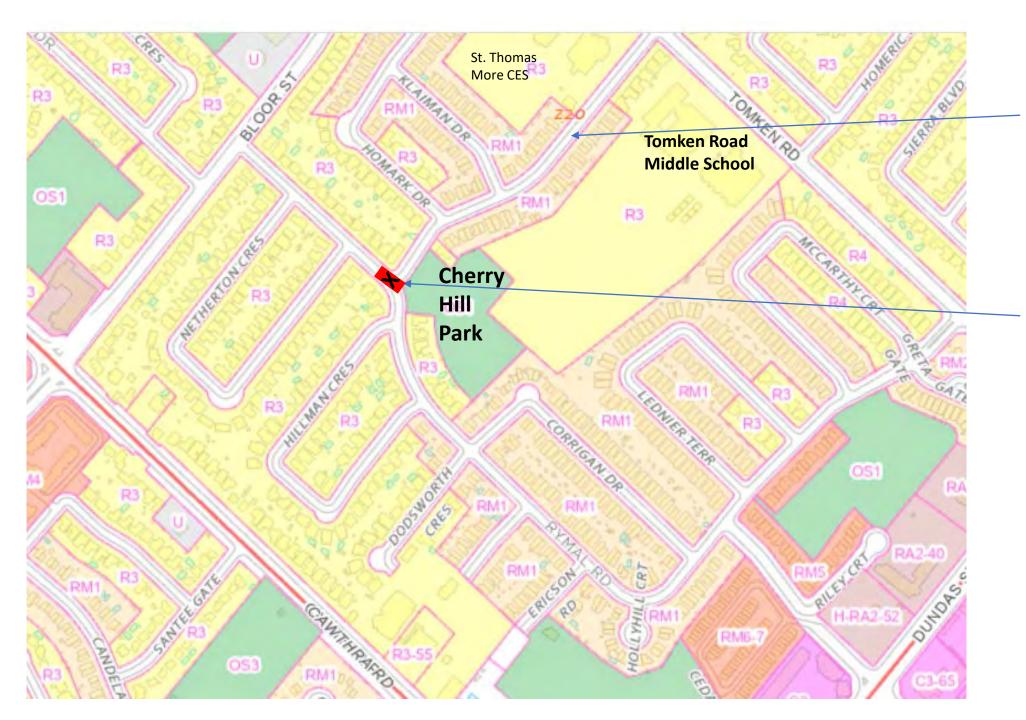

Traffic Calming on Flagship Road (Item # 9.5, App. 1) Request for Continuation of Traffic Calming for Rymal Road

Flagship Drive

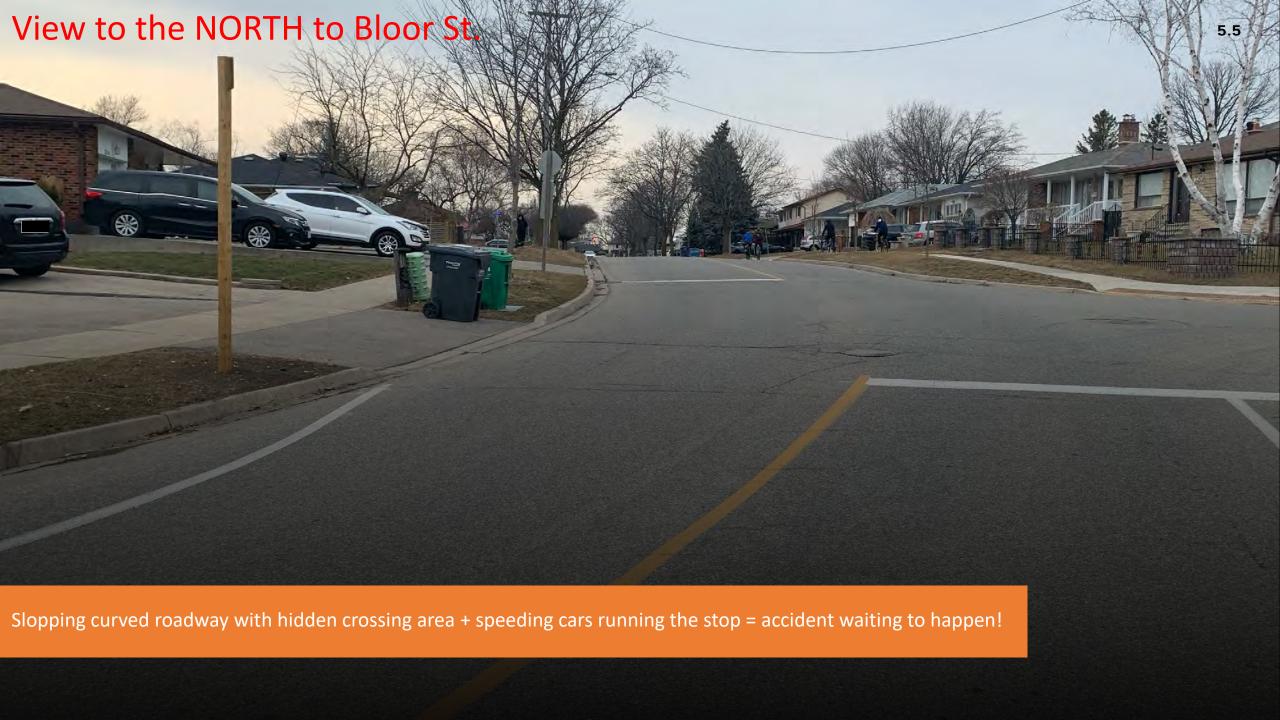
(Proposed speed bumps or ASE traffic calming measures)

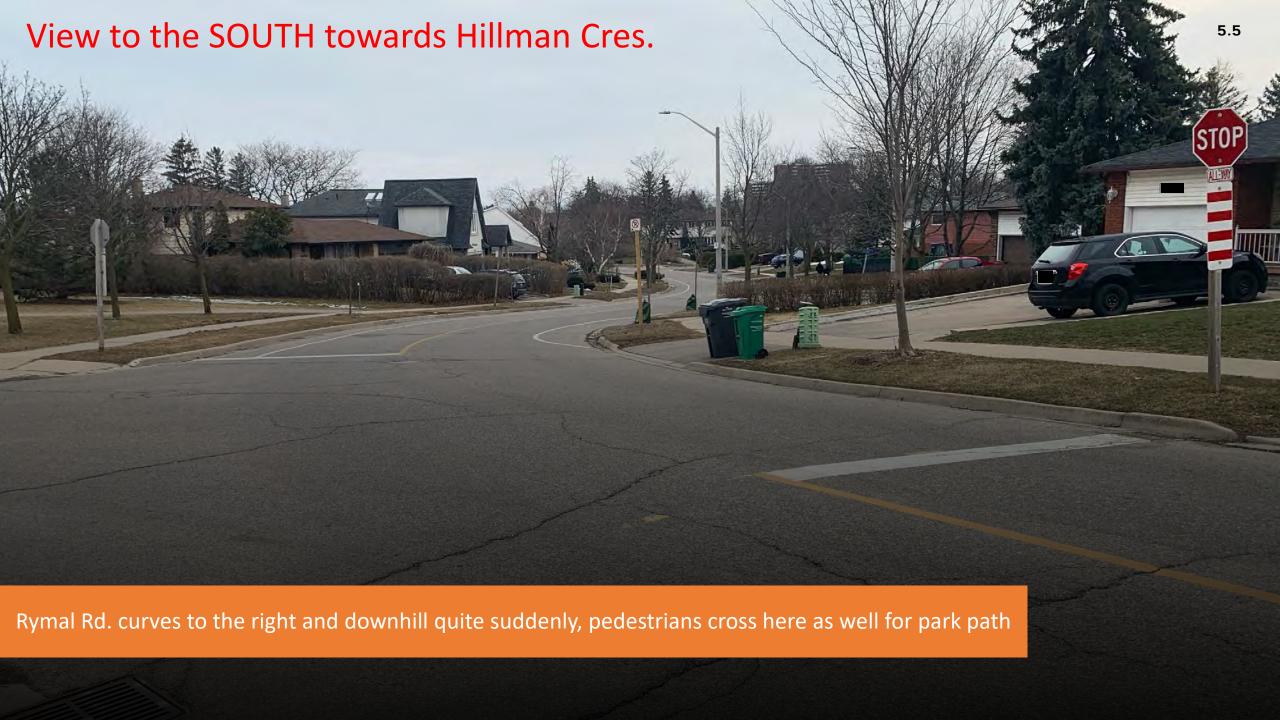
3 Way Stop at Rymal Rd. & Flagship Dr.

(Excessive speeds + Running of stop sign)

ISSUE: No Stopping at the 3-way sign at Rymal Rd. & Flagship Dr.













 Community video showing the STOP sign concerns at Rymal & Flagship was sent to council and we would appreciate you viewing the live action NON-STOP insanity. STOP sign is merely a suggestion on Rymal and needs to be addressed.

2. Community Petition Results:

- 35 Residences on Rymal Road from Bloor St. to Hillman Cres. were contacted.
- 80% of these residents agree that speeding is a major problem, and that action needs to be taken, before a serious accident or major injury occurs.
- 80% (27 residents) support traffic calming measures on this stretch.
- In addition to the speed and non-stopping of vehicles at the neighbourhood stop signs, it has been noticed, by several residents, that there is also a noticeable increase in traffic using Rymal Road south as a detour, presumably to access Tomken Road towards Dundas.

Specifically, after the traffic lights were installed at the Bloor/Rymal corner.



Our Proposal with 80% community support:

Traffic calming measures, that are currently being proposed for Flagship Drive or the ASE, to be continued on Rymal Rd., slightly north and south of the Rymal Rd. & Flagship Dr. 3 way sign.
