
# **Malton Community Centre Information**

- 72,215 sq. ft. (6,709 sq. m.), two-stories with partial basement
- Amenities include, a library, gymnasium, weight room, change, shower and washrooms, multipurpose rooms, storage and administrative office space

The purpose of the project is to replace aging building components and make accessibility improvements in order to reduce maintenance costs and improve the day-to-day operations and condition of this public facility.




# **Project Objectives**

- Minimize the likelihood of equipment failure
- Improve the performance and efficiency of the mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems
- Improve accessibility of the facility
- Enhance the condition of community centre and library for the staff and public users experience

# **Project Scope**

- Replacing the library circulation desk
- Installing new ADOs where required
- Upgrading the washrooms
- Flooring replacement in the library and fitness room
- Replacing mechanical and plumbing equipment
- Replacing the power distribution equipment
- Replacing and repairing sections of the roof































Library – Existing Stairs, Ramps, and Quiet Room








**Library – Existing Circulation Desk**
