#### 9. OTHER BUSINESS

A. Hardy joined the meeting at 9:43 am.

John Dunlop, Supervisor, Heritage Planning provided an update on the intent to designate two structures on the property located at 1200 Old Derry Road and noted that the City received a notice of objection in regards to the intent to designate. Mr. Dunlop noted that the matter would be referred to the Conservation Review Board and that the property owner had scheduled a deputation for the February 11, 2020 Heritage Advisory Committee (HAC). Councillor Carlson advised the committee that the owner of 1200 Old Derry Road had agreed to allow members of HAC to attend a site visit to view the two structures. Councillor Carlson noted that he would advise the committee of the date of the site visit once it was determined.

Councillor Parrish provided a brief update on the status of the QEW Credit River Bridge and noted that the committee contributed in saving the bridge from demolition.

Matthew Wilkinson, Citizen Member inquired if the City's Dundas Connects project would impact any heritage properties. Councillor Carlson advised that no concrete

decisions had been made and that Council would look for possible solutions to not impact nearby heritage properties.

John Dunlop, Supervisor, Heritage Planning advised the committee that Mississauga would be hosting the 2020 Peel Heritage Committees meeting, which would include members and staff from the Heritage Committees of Brampton, Caledon, Mississauga and the Peel Archives (PAMA). Mr. Dunlop noted that the meeting would take place on Friday, June 19, 2020 at the Small Arms Inspection Building, 1352 Lakeshore Road East.

Councillor Parrish provided a brief update on the status of the Avro Arrow project, which included the status of the manufacturing contracts and funding.
