
Project Route & Scope

- 18 km route from the Port Credit GO Station in Mississauga to the Brampton Gateway Terminal
- 19 stops serving two urban growth centres and four mobility hubs, connections with two GO Transit rail lines, the Mississauga Transitway, Brampton Züm and MiWay
- Clean, electrically powered light rail vehicles, producing near zero emissions






Project Timeline

Cross-Section




Cycling Treatment on the Corridor



Stage 1: Median removals and installation of temporary traffic signals.




Stage 2: Partial road closure on Hurontario Street.
