

School **Streets** PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLIST ZONE Mon - Fri 8:00 - 8:30 am 3:00 - 3:30 pm

- Create temporary car-free environments in front of schools at start and/or end of school day
- Make space for walking, cycling and other active travel



Introducing: School Streets



- Why School Streets?
 - Improves road safety
 - Creates opportunities for kids to be active
 - Benefits mental health and focus at school
 - Improves air quality at and around schools
 - Builds community



School Streets Pilot Project

- To Launch May 2022 at 2 sites
 - 3 weeks per location
- West Location: Hillside PS
- East Location: St Alfred Separate School and Brian W. Fleming PS
- Local project planning teams developed and meeting this winter; Community Meetings in April 2022
- We will need volunteers!







Three schools in the city will be taking part in a School Streets pilot project, which will create safe and communityfriendly spaces for residents to get to school.
