#### 6. MATTERS CONSIDERED

#### 6.1. Review of Annual Awards for 2021

At this time, Tamara Coulson, Citizen Member abstained from voting due to a perceived conflict of interest as she works for one of the schools participating in the School Streets Pilot Program.

Due to the school closures resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, the subcommittee recommended the awards be cancelled for 2021 and that the funding be reallocated to support the schools still participating in the School Streets Pilot Program. The subcommittee discussed providing the funding to the School Streets Pilot program schools in the spring.
