 - 12 groups going into their 2nd year of multi-funding
- 20 established A&C groups, 5 new groups
- 15 established Cultural Festivals, 2 new Festivals



2022 Updates - Culture Project Grant

Theme - Unifying Arts for Social Justice

- Anti-racism, anti-hate efforts and community building in Mississauga
- 12 applications; 9 recommended



2022 Updates - Community

- One-year extensions to 7 multi-year agreements for established groups:
 - Active Adult Centre of Mississauga; Ecosource; Erin Mills Youth Centre;
 Mississauga Sports Council; Riverwood Conservancy; Safe City
 Mississauga: Volunteer MBC
- New one year agreement with The Dam (Develop-Assist-Mentor)
- 17 applications received for one year operating/project grants including 7 first time applicants
 - 8 organizations to receive funding
