## What are we doing?

- Updating pedestrian crossing times at approximately 800 intersections city-wide
- Helps Mississauga achieve Vision Zero by prioritizing pedestrian crossing at signalized intersections
- Ontario Traffic Manual guidelines were revised, resulting in Mississauga revising our guidelines
- The City of Mississauga is exceeding OTM guidelines to prioritize pedestrian safety
- Staff are coordinating with Regional staff for signalized intersections on Regional Roads within Mississauga

#### **Current Guideline**



• Total crossing time at an intersection will be based off a calculation specific to the intersection's geometrics
