This memorandum and its attachment are presented for the Heritage Advisory Committee's information.

Section 7.4.1.12 of the Mississauga Official Plan states that: "The proponent of any construction, development, or property alteration that might adversely affect a listed or designated cultural heritage resource or which is proposed adjacent to a cultural heritage resource will be required to submit a Heritage Impact Assessment, prepared to the satisfaction of the City and other appropriate authorities having jurisdiction."

The property owner has proposed to redevelop the property. The property is not recognized under the OHA; however it is adjacent to the Benares Historic House which is recognized under Part IV of the OHA and protected by an Ontario Heritage Trust Conservation Easement.

Based on the results of the field survey, the location of the proposed development, and the existing vegetative buffers between the two properties, no direct impacts of the proposed development on the cultural heritage value or heritage attributes associated with Benares Historic House were identified. Potential indirect impacts to the existing buffer zone of mature trees were identified. Mitigation measures can be found in Appendix 1.
