Subject

Single Source Contract Award to Aramark Canada Ltd. For Food Services for the 2022 Ontario Summer Games

Recommendation

That the Purchasing Agent or designate be authorized to execute a contract with Aramark Canada Ltd. on a Single Source basis for food services for the 2022 Ontario Summer Games at University of Toronto Mississauga (UTM), in the estimated amount of \$550,000 as outlined in the Corporate Report dated February 1, 2022 from the Commissioner of Community Services.

Executive Summary

- The City of Mississauga is hosting the 2022 Ontario Parasport Games, which run from May 13 to May 15, 2022 and the 2022 Ontario Summer Games, which run from July 21 to 24, 2022.
- Food services for the 2022 Ontario Summer Games are required at University of Toronto Mississauga (UTM). Aramark Canada Ltd. (Aramark) has a contract with UTM giving them exclusive rights to provide food services at UTM facilities and are a Single Source.
- The Purchasing By-law No. 374-2016 provides for single source awards under these circumstances under Schedule "A" 1. (a) the Goods and/or Services are only available from one supplier by reason of (iii) the existence of exclusive rights such as patent, copyright or license. Single Source awards with a value of more than \$100,000 require Council approval.
- Final requirements and quantities are pending. The City will negotiate requirements and enter into a contract directly with Aramark, in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor, in the estimated amount of \$550,000.

Background

The City of Mississauga is hosting the 2022 Ontario Parasport Games, which run from May 13 to 15, 2022 and the 2022 Ontario Summer Games, which run from July 21 – 24, 2022.

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The Ontario Parasport Games will see 532 athletes competing in 8 events across 4 city venues. While the Ontario Summer Games will see 3300 athletes competing in 21 events across 18 city venues. Additionally team coaches, managers, games officials and volunteers will also be hosted for the duration of both games.

Comments

Food services for the 2022 Ontario Parasport Games, May 13 to 15, 2022, will be provided at the Paramount Fine Food Centre (PFFC). Paramount's existing contract with the City gives them exclusive rights to provide food services at the PFFC. No additional approval is required.

Food services for the 2022 Ontario Summer Games, July 21 to 24, 2022, are required at University of Toronto Mississauga (UTM). Aramark Canada Ltd. (Aramark) has a contract with UTM giving them exclusive rights to provide food services at UTM facilities and are a Single Source. The Purchasing By-law No. 374-2016 provides for single source awards under these circumstances under Schedule "A" 1. (a) the Goods and/or Services are only available from one supplier by reason of (iii) the existence of exclusive rights such as patent, copyright or license. Single Source awards with a value of more than \$100,000 require Council approval.

Budget for Ontario Summer Games food for lunch and dinner at UTM is approximately \$550,000.00.

Financial Impact

The estimated cost is \$550,000. Funds are available in cost centre 24610, GL 715856.
