12. OTHER BUSINESS

Robert Leuschner, Citizen Member enquired when Mississauga Cycling Advisory Committee (MCAC) Meetings would resume in person. Fonseca requested that the members of MCAC schedule a ride in the future.

Suzanne Doyle, Vice Chair spoke to the 2022 Ontario Bike Summit and enquired if members of the committee could be sponsored to attend the event.
