4) THAT PEEL REGIONAL POLICE BE REQUESTED TO ENFORCE SPEEDING ON BRISTOL ROAD WEST IN THE AREA OF HEATHERLEIGH AVENUE BETWEEN THE PEAK TIMES OF 8:00 - 8:30 AM AND 3:00 - 3:30 PM, AS TIME AND RESOURCES PERMIT.
