The property at 1571 Adamson Street is listed on the City's heritage register as part of the Erindale Village Cultural Heritage Landscape. Section 7.4.1.12 of the Mississauga Official Plan states that: "The proponent of any construction, development, or property alteration that might adversely affect a listed or designated cultural heritage resource or which proposed adjacent to a cultural heritage resource will be required to submit a Heritage Impact Assessment, prepared to the satisfaction of the City and other appropriate authorities having jurisdiction." A scoped Heritage Impact Assessment report is attached for your reference. This HIA meets the requirements however, staff may still have comments as part of the Site Plan process.
