
Light Nuisance Concerns from residents on the Redeveloped Applewood Heights Secondary School's Community Field turned to Sports Field with Addition of 4-80' high Stadium Lights Standards.

Neighbouring Residents to Field

- There has been and continues to be **light nuisance**, **pollution**, **glare**, **trespass and noise** created as a result of the 4-80 foot high stadium light standards erected in the Redevelopment of the Applewood Heights Secondary School's community field.
- As a result, neighbouring residents do not have enjoyment of their residential properties when the school's field lights are on.
- Concerns about the issues and impact the light standards would have to the neighbouring residents were expressed to PDSB and City of Mississauga staff, Ward Councillor and to Council (through the Ward Councillor) by the neighbouring residents after learning of PDSB's plans on Sat. March 31st, 2018; and, as a community made great effort for the lights not to be erected so that such concerns to neighbours would be avoided.
- The light nuisance and noise concerns addressed by the neighbouring community were not acknowledged by the PDSB nor City Council and staff.
- In early July 2018 the 4-80 foot high stadium lights were erected and have been in full use since September 2018 resulting in this light nuisance and other issues whenever they are lit.

On May 23, 2018, the PDSB staff did not show Council any visual of the field with the proximity to the residential properties.

And no city permits were needed for any of the redevelopments.




Construction began mid-June 2018 ended start of September 2018


The following 3 slides show the backyard view of homes abutting the Applewood Heights SS field from the North side on Pinesmoke Crescent when there are No stadium lights on.

This is how it was before this community school field was redeveloped prior to September 2018.


From ground level of backyard of home on Pinesmoke when NO lights are on the AHSS field.



From backyard of residential property on Pinesmoke when NO lights from the AHSS's redeveloped school field are lit.




From ground level of backyard of Pinesmoke Residence (unlit light pole visible in the distance)

View from street on Pinesmoke. Abutting residential properties on the field's north side. Light pollution from one light pole only.




Pulling into residential driveway on Pinesmoke and light pollution from 2 light poles only.




View from street on Pinesmoke of the 2 poles on field's east side:




2nd photo of **Light Trespass &** Glare: From the AHSS field lights, shadows result in the backyard of Pinesmoke residences that are next to field.

The neighbouring residents enjoyment of their residential properties is completely affected and not possible when the 4 newly erected stadium lights at Applewood Heights Sec. school field are lit; and, which result in light pollution, glare, trespass and nuisance to them.



Community's Requests are:

City Enforcement of the Light Nuisance By-Law *and* Current timing of the AHSS's field stadium lights being on to be decreased to 9 pm.
