

## **CYCLIST VS PEDESTRIAN SIGNAGE**

**Rules for use of trails (MUT's) exist for cyclist  
but equally should exist for pedestrians.**

**Why do they not exist for pedestrians?**



**This sign indicating etiquette for cyclist's use of trails, while supported by cyclists, without an equivalent etiquette sign for pedestrians tends to create a negative impression of cyclists.**

**WOULD SIGNAGE FOR PEDESTRIAN'S ETIQUETTE ON TRAILS INCLUDING PICTURES, AS PER 3 EXAMPLES, BE OUT OF PLACE?**

**Please walk no more than 2 abreast and stay to the right sight side.**

**Pedestrians with dogs on leashes both stay on the right side of path.**

**You will not hear bike bells with earphones or headsets on. Stay to the right.**
