Rules for use of trails (MUT's) exist for cyclist but equally should exist for pedestrians.

Why do they not exist for pedestrians?



WOULD SIGNAGE FOR PEDESTRIAN'S ETIQUETTE ON TRAILS INCLUDING PICTURES, AS PER 3 EXAMPLES, BE OUT OF PLACE?

Please walk no more than 2 abreast and stay to the right sight side.

Pedestrians with dogs on leashes both stay on the right side of path.

You will not hear bike bells with earphones or headsets on. Stay to the right.
