Award 1 - Youth/School Cycling

This award is presented annually to a person/group who meets the following criteria:

- 1. The nominee must be a student or group of students, between the ages of 12 and 18, attending an elementary, middle or secondary school in the City of Mississauga.
- 2. Someone (or a group of people) who has/have encouraged and promoted cycling amongst their peers and/or set an example for safe cycling.
- 3. The Mississauga Cycling Advisory Promotions Subcommittee will be the Nominating Committee to request, review and recommend nominations annually to MCAC.
- 4. The nominations will be ratified at the end of the calendar year and presented in City Council in February of every year.

Award 2 - Business Award

This award is presented annually to a person/business who meets the following criteria:

- 1. Nominees can be: A business or business owner in the City of Mississauga.
- 2. Nominations are accepted for a business that has encouraged cycling among its employees and/or customers by breaking down barriers to cycling for example with bicycle parking, discounts for cyclists, and more.
- 3. The Mississauga Cycling Advisory Promotions Subcommittee will be the Nominating Committee to request, review and recommend nominations annually to MCAC.
- 4. The nominations will be ratified at the end of the calendar year and presented in City Council in February of every year.

Award 3 - Cycling Equity, Diversity & Inclusion Award

This award is presented annually to a person/group who meets the following criteria:

- 1. Nominees can be: Any person or group residing or working in the City of Mississauga.
- 2. Nominations are accepted for a person or a group of people who have helped improve access for those who may experience barriers to cycling (i.e., people with disabilities, low-income households, other marginalized group, etc.)."
- 3. The Mississauga Cycling Advisory Promotions Subcommittee will be the Nominating Committee to request, review and recommend nominations annually to MCAC.
- 4. The nominations will be ratified at the end of the calendar year alongside other Mississauga Cycling Advisory Committee awards and presented in City Council in February of every year.
