**Petition against 40 and 42 story buildings on the Port Credit GO Parking site (south-east side)**

We demand that the Planning and Development Committee of the City 'not accept' or request a 'significant reduction' to the proposed 40 and 42 story buildings on the Port Credit GO Parking site. The addition of such tall buildings in Port Credit will be of negative impact to residents.

Having 40 and 42 story buildings (i.e., over 600 feet high) with limited parking spaces at the corner of Hurontario and Park Street East will have an impact on the quality of life on the residents of Port Credit. The following are examples into what will happen. It will:

- eliminate much needed parking in the Port Credit area for local residents who drive into Port credit Go station and anyone coming to Port Credit from the surrounding areas;
- significantly increase congestion at a key intersection;
- significantly increase air and noise pollution;
- significantly increase local traffic and parking on side streets in front of resident homes, **given there are only 474 parking spaces for 1139 dwellings + commercial + office space;**
- significantly diminish sunlight to the adjacent retiree residences on Hurontario and Park Street East by at least 4 hours a day;
- **set a new precedence** for all future projects going forward in Port Credit;
- increase Airbnb lodging and absenteeism landlords;
- tarnish Port Credit's reputation as a peaceful area and touristic destination ;
- significantly extend rush hours; and
- increase 'global warming' effects on Port Credit.

Port Credit does not need 2 buildings that are twice as high as any other building in the Lakeshore/Hurontario area. We call on the Planning and Development Committee of Mississauga to 'not accept' or request a 'significant reduction' to the proposed 40 and 42 story buildings.















