### 2023 Grant Recommendations

- 98 grant applications received
- 88 organizations to receive funding:
  - > 80 eligible applications recommended for funding
    - > 10 new groups
  - ➤ 8 Culture organizations entering the next year of their multi-year agreement
  - 6 Community Groups entering multi-year agreements
