- Approved by Council in 2012
- 9 sections:
 - Transportation
 - Urban Form
 - Natural Heritage / Natural Areas System
 - Air
 - Energy
 - Water
 - Waste
 - Organization & Policy
 - Education Programs
- Raised the profile of environmental sustainability at the City
- Called for the creation of the Environment Division
- Collaborative effort by staff across the City
