### **Consolidated Recommendation**

The City recommends that the Committee have regard for all comments and evidence provided by the applicant and area residents when assessing if the application meets the requirements of Section 45(1) of the Planning Act.

# **Application Details**

The applicant requests the Committee to approve a minor variance to allow the construction of a pool proposing a side yard setback to pool equipment of 0.30m (approx. 0.98ft) whereas By-law 0225-2007, as amended requires a minimum side yard setback of 0.60m (approx. 1.97ft) in this instance.

**Site and Area Context** 

The subject property is located within the Port Credit Neighbourhood (East) Character Area, southwest of the Hiawatha Parkway and Lakeshore Road East intersection. The immediate neighbourhood is primarily residential. The residential uses consist of one and two-storey detached dwellings on lots with mature vegetation in the front yard. The subject property contains a two-storey detached dwelling with vegetation in the front yard.

The applicant is proposing pool equipment with a reduced side yard setback.



## **Comments**

#### **Planning**

Section 45 of the *Planning Act* provides the Committee of Adjustment with the authority to grant relief from the requirements of a municipal zoning by-law. Approval of applications must meet the requirements set out under 45(1) and/or 45(2) (a) or (b) in the *Planning Act*.

Staff comments concerning the application are as follows:

The subject property is located within Port Credit Neighbourhood (East) and is designated Residential Low Density I by the Mississauga Official Plan (MOP). The Residential Low Density I designation permits detached dwellings.

The general intent of this portion of the by-law is to ensure that an adequate buffer exists between the abutting properties and to accommodate an adequate swale for drainage purposes.

Staff have no massing concerns with the proposed equipment. Furthermore, access to the rear yard is maintained via the opposite side yard. Transportation and Works staff have not raised any drainage related concerns at this time. Through a detailed review of the application, staff

are of the opinion that the application is appropriate to be handled through the minor variance process. Further, the application raises no concerns of a planning nature.
