Mississauga Fire & Emergency Services (MFES) has a 10-year capital plan to renovate thirteen (13) fire stations across the City.

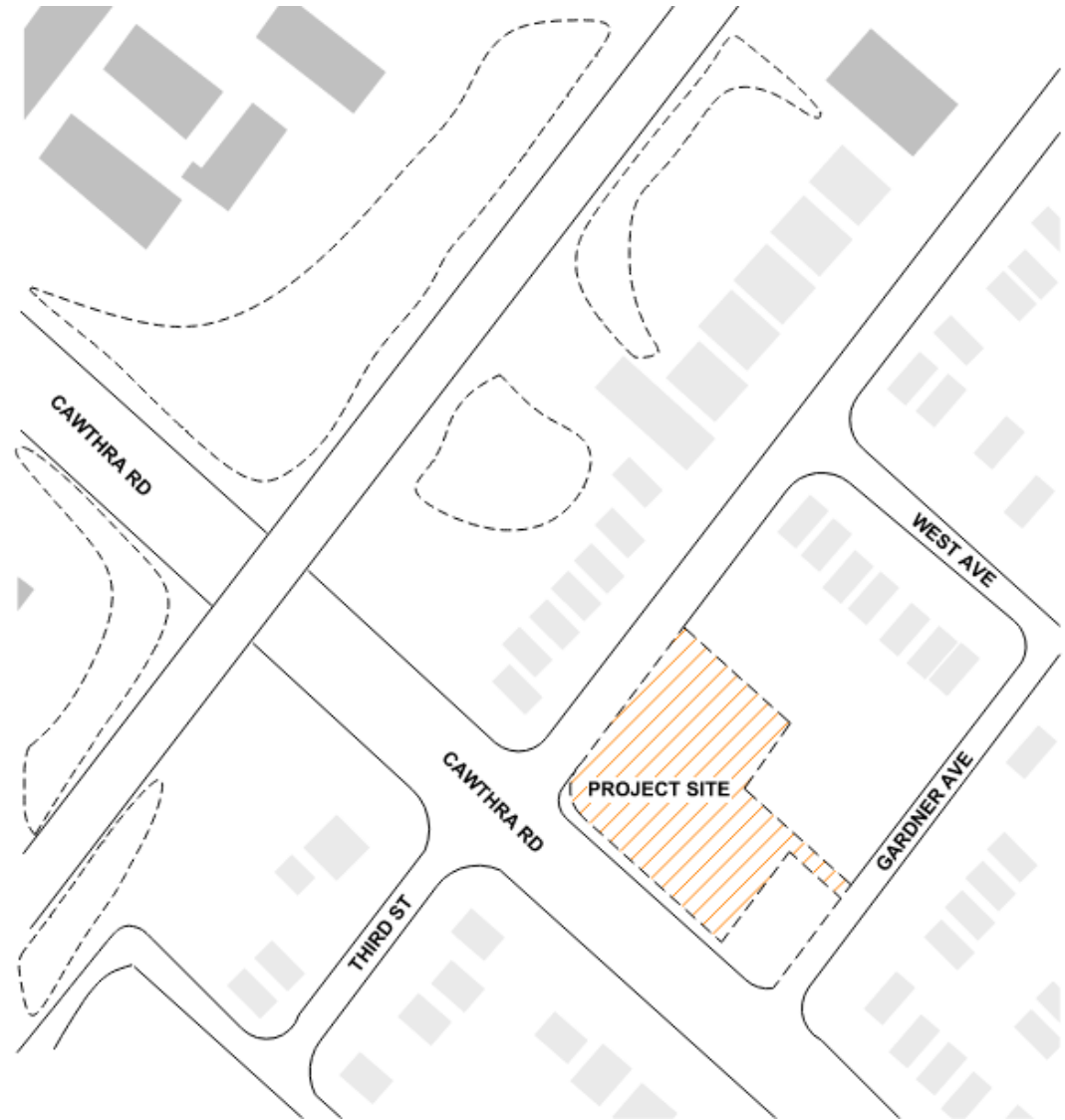
Fire Stations 102 and 108 are the first to be renovated.

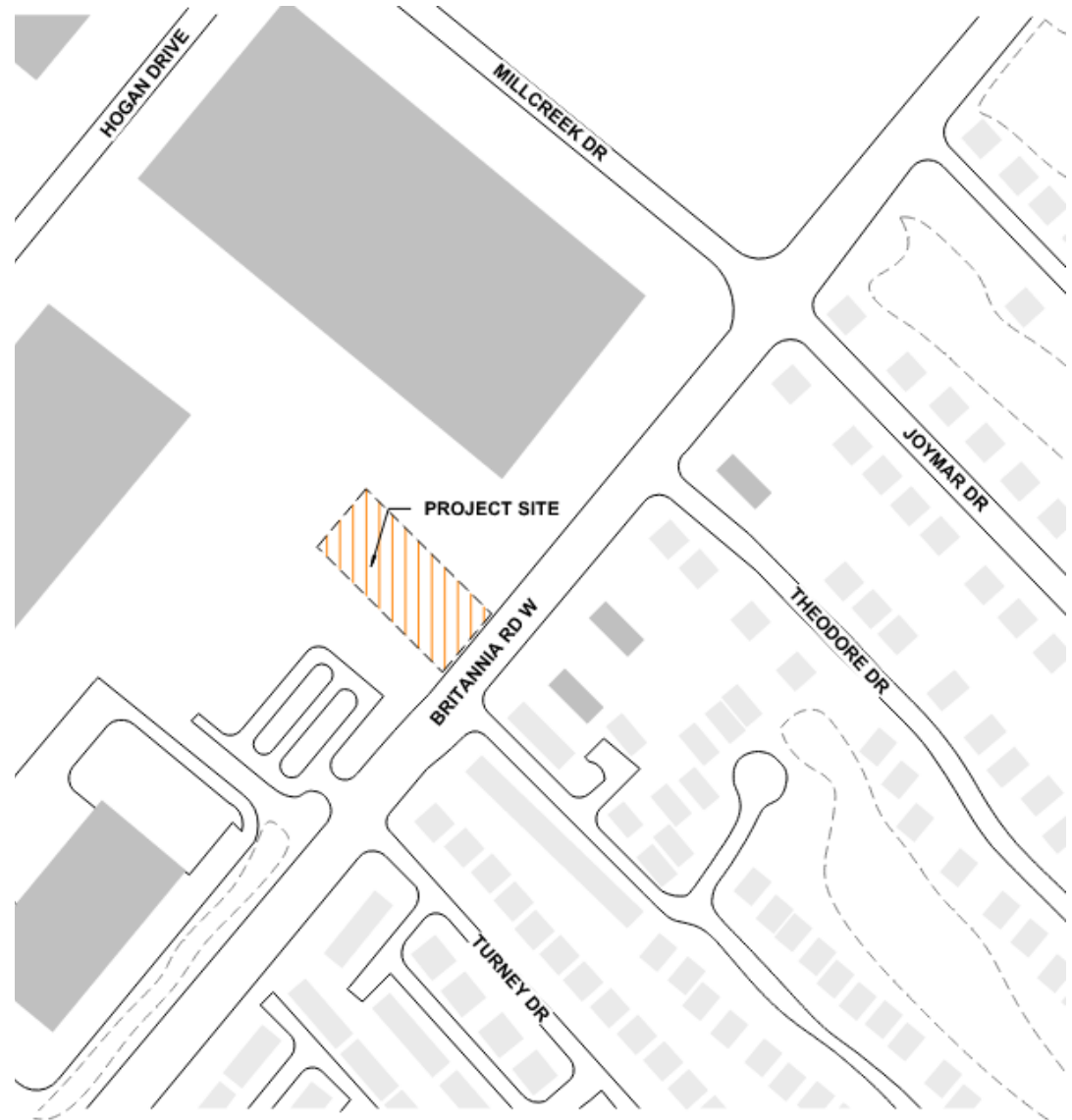

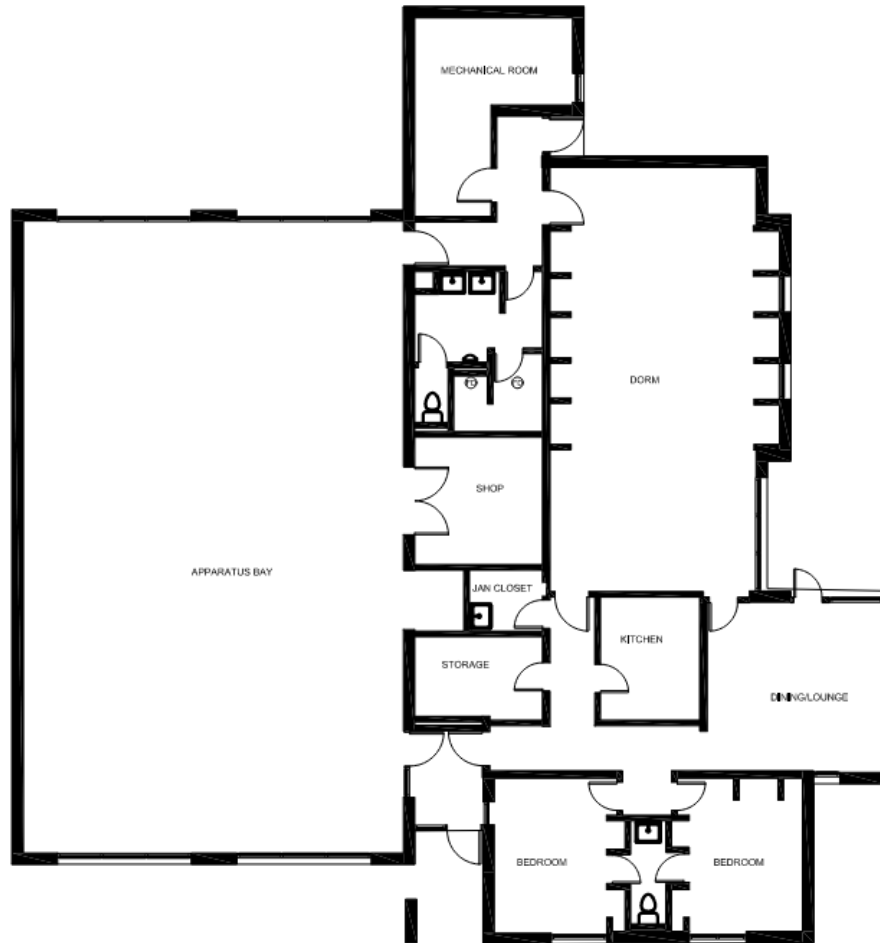

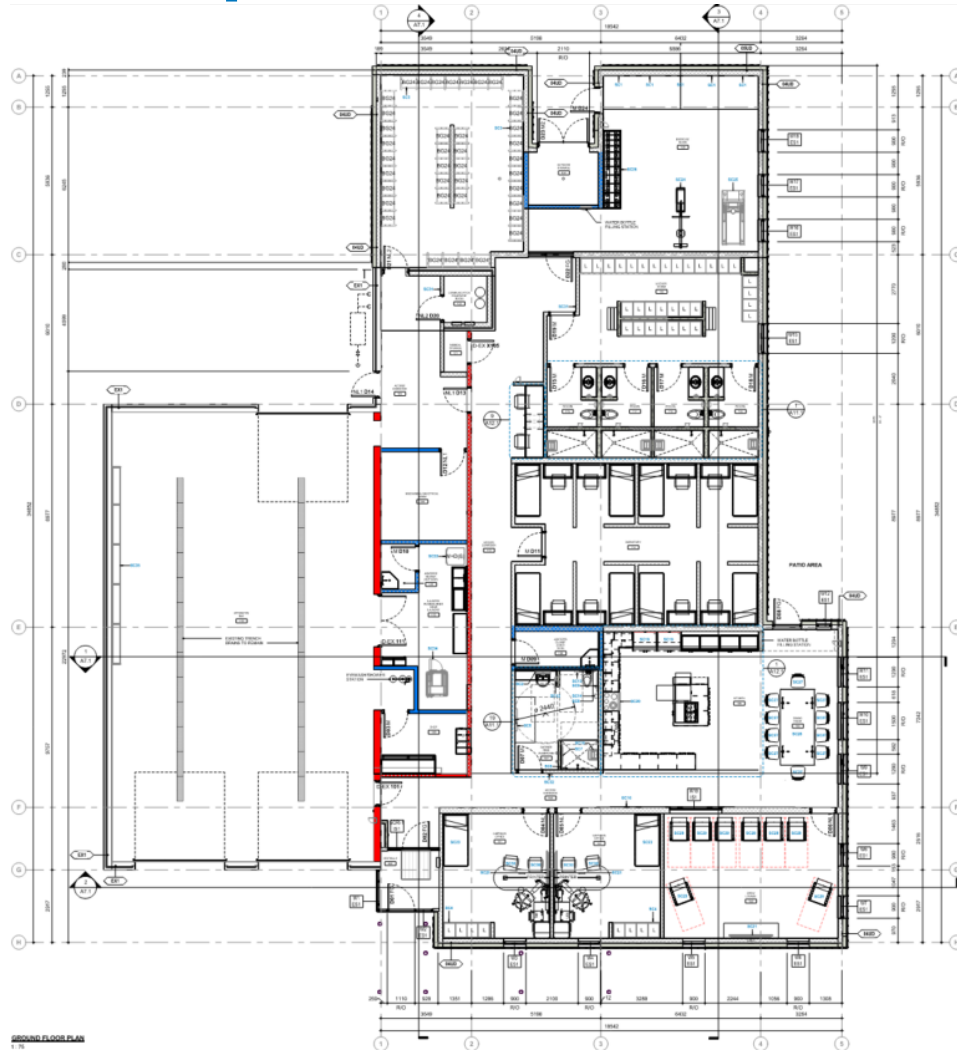
Project Scope and Objectives

3. Provide an accessible entrance vestibule with an emergency phone

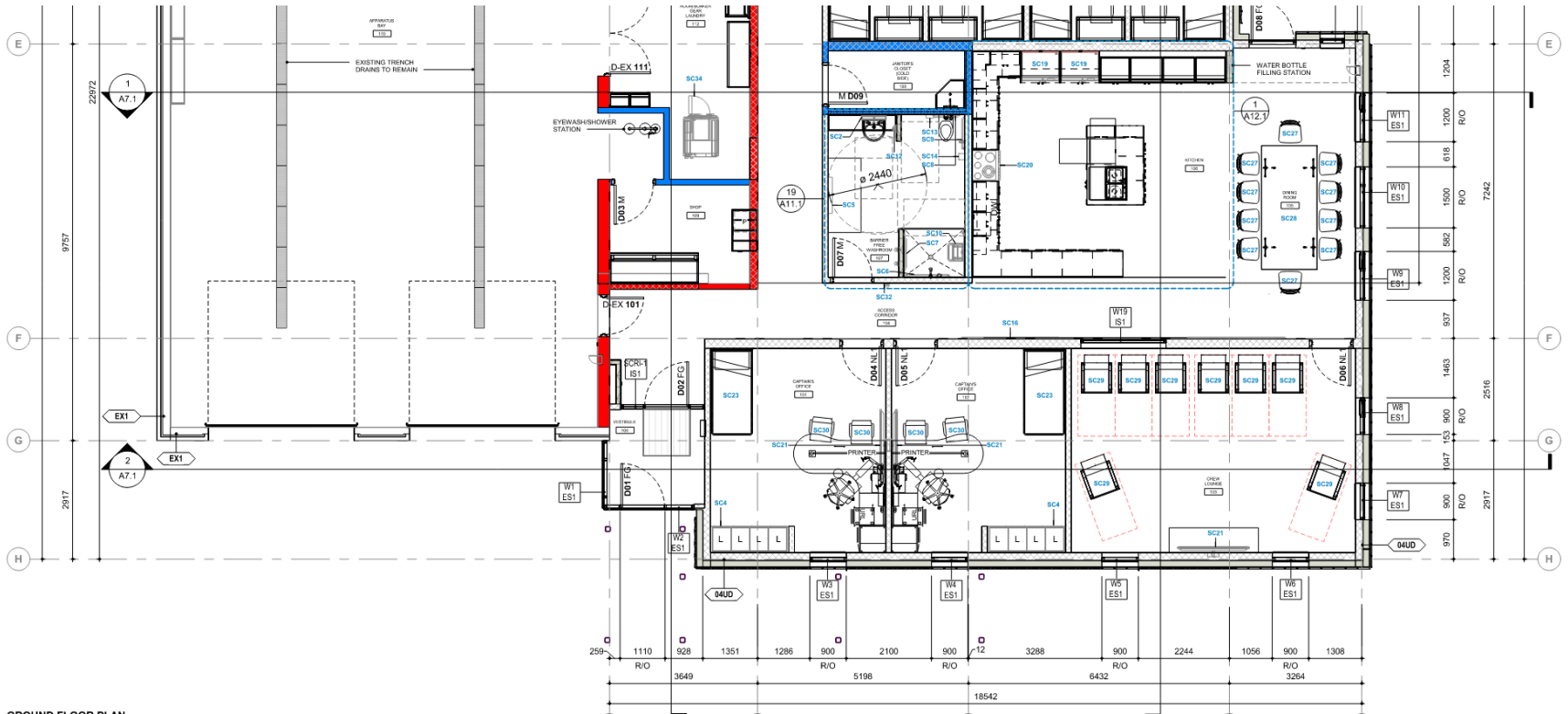

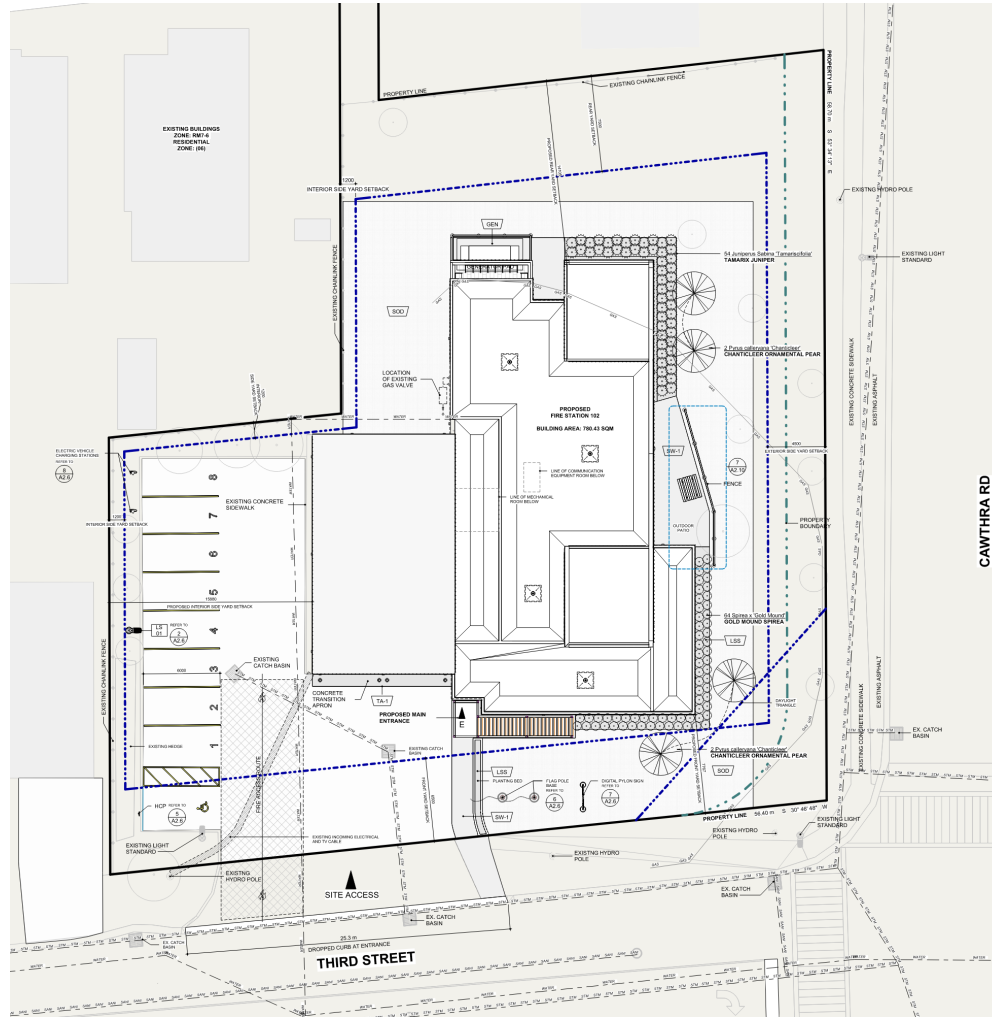
FS 102: Proposed Floor Plan

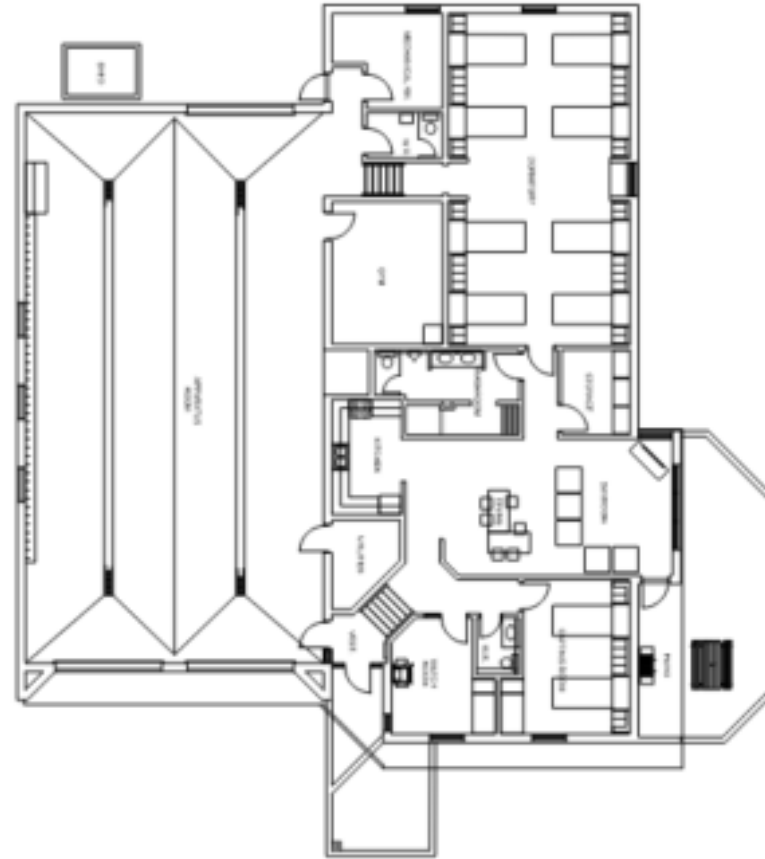

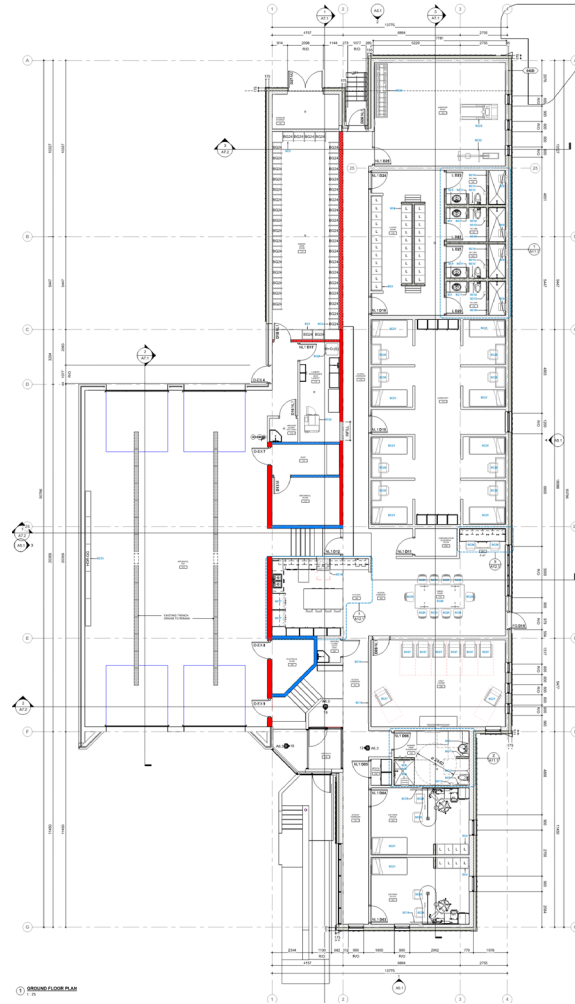

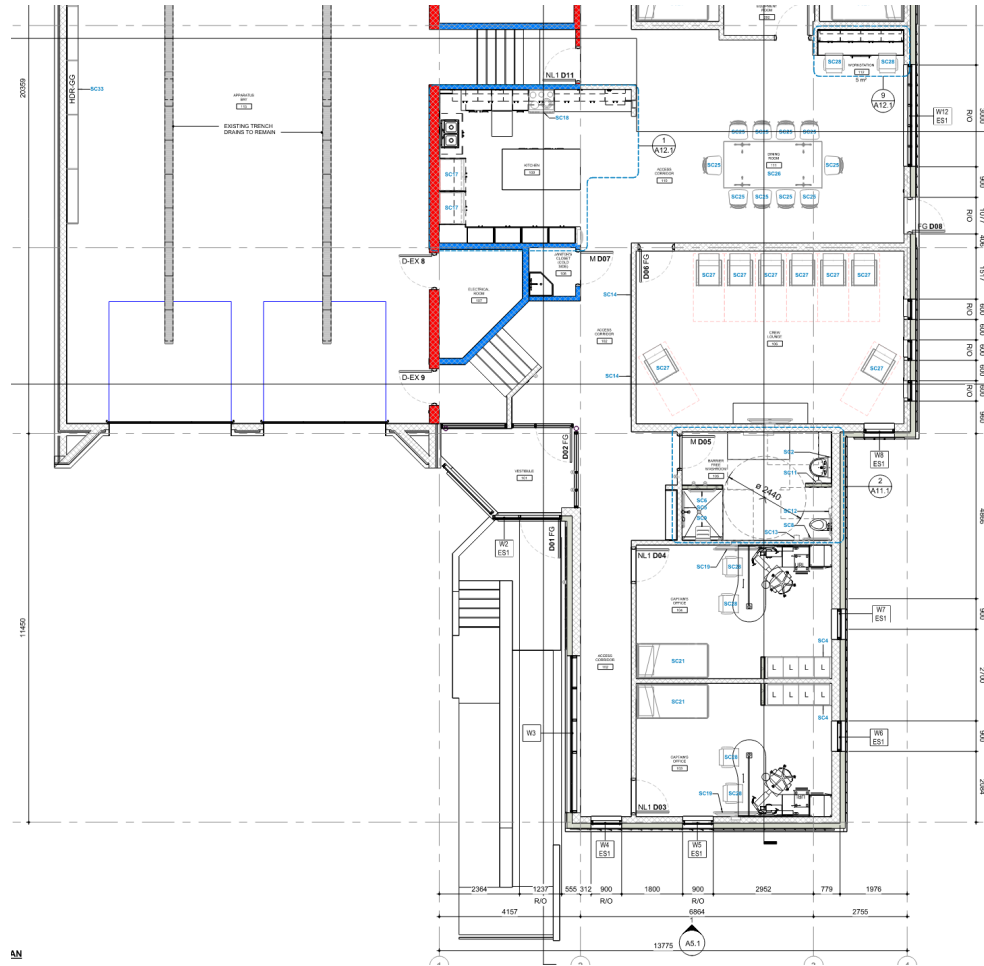
FS 108: Existing Floor Plan



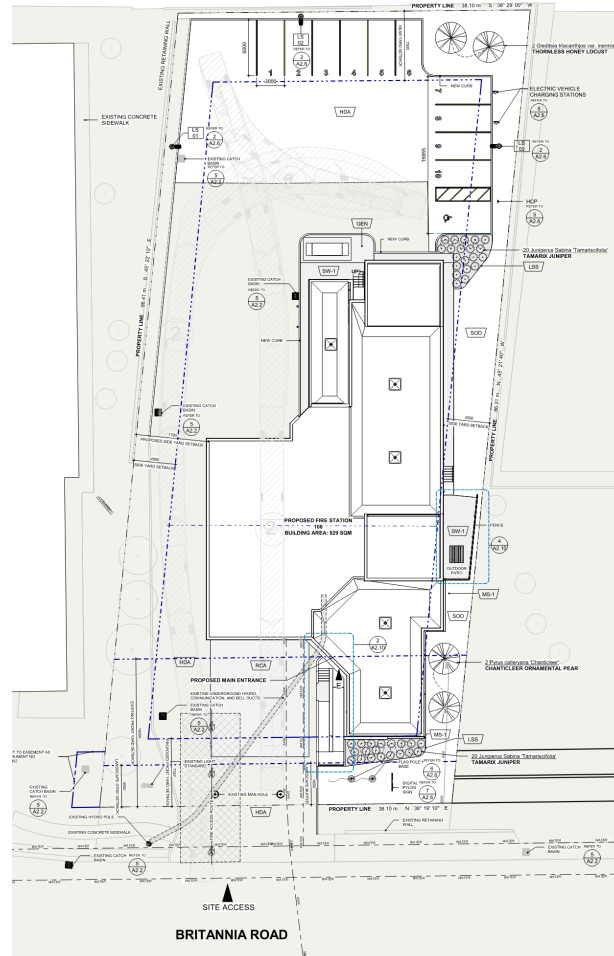
