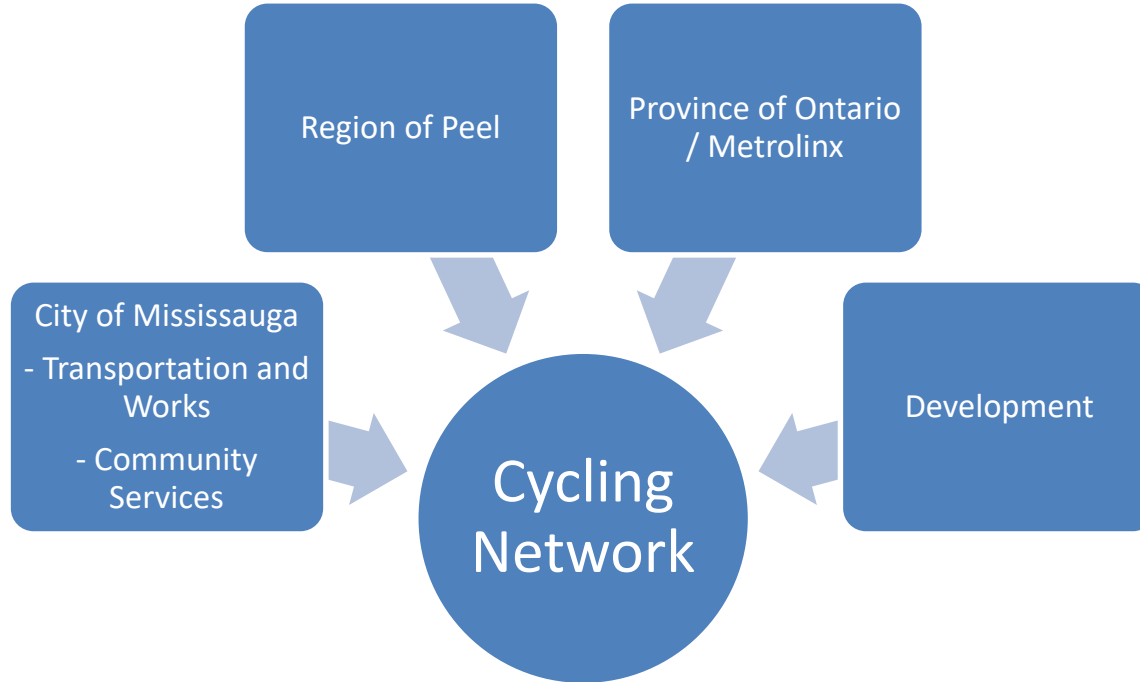

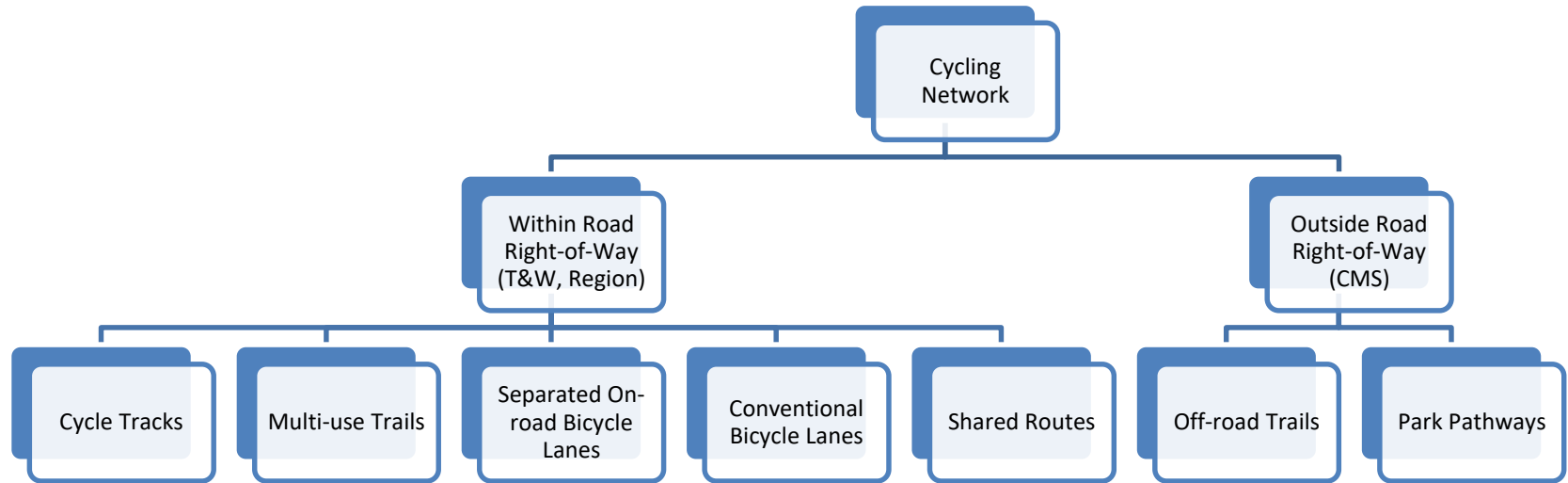




# Cycling Network Layers

# CMP Update - Beginning Summer 2023

# MCAC Roles and Responsibilities

- Current Committee Work Plan Structure
  - Annual Work Plan – approved by GC, including budget requests
  - Action List – tracking of issues for follow-up, staff response or action, etc
- Current Subcommittee Structure
  - Network and Technical Subcommittee – review and provide feedback on proposed infrastructure design, assist with Community Rides
  - Communications Subcommittee – run the Annual MCAC Awards program

# MCAC Roles and Responsibilities

- Proposed Ongoing Activities
  - Receive staff reports and recommendations to pass on to GC for ratification ie infrastructure projects, policy proposals, programs
  - Community / Local Ward Engagement - working with staff or independently in coordination to promote cycling in your ward / neighbourhood, as part of infrastructure project planning or in advance of future works to identify needs and build community support for cycling
  - Attend City booths on behalf of AT - help extend the reach of City outreach efforts by volunteering at pop-up booths or event booths

# MCAC Roles and Responsibilities

- Community Rides
  - Route planning and ground-truthing (3-4 members)
  - Marshalling (as many members as possible)
  - Volunteering at City host booth (1-2 members)
- Cycling Master Plan Update
  - Focus groups throughout the project timeline; subcommittee? (maximum 5 members)
  - Preparing and submitting a supporting report recommending approval of staff report (all)
- Cycling Tourism
  - Engage Mississauga businesses and BIAs (3-4 members)
  - Partner with Ontario by Bike to host a Bicycle Tourism Workshop (3-4 members)
- Annual MCAC Awards
  - Communications Plan (1-2 members)
  - Review nominations and select winners (4-5 members)
