Compliance with the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996 and By-law 0205-2021 is also required by the candidate in order for a contributor to be eligible for a rebate.

## Eligibility for a Rebate

- Rebates are only applicable for contributions made to candidates running for office on the City of Mississauga's Municipal Council
- To be eligible, contributors must be eligible to vote in the province of Ontario and THEY MUST NOT BE a candidate or the spouse or child of a candidate
- Contributions must be monetary and must be made in a way that links the contributor's name and account to the contribution; cash contributions are ineligible
- The minimum eligible contribution is \$100

## Candidate Responsibilities

- Communicate *Municipal Elections Act* contribution rules and Rebate Program rules to the contributors
- Complete general Campaign Contribution Receipts (supplied by the candidate) for every contribution even if it is NOT eligible for a rebate
- Complete a Contribution Rebate Request form for every contribution that IS eligible for a rebate
- Provide one copy of the Contribution Rebate Request form to the contributor, retain one for your records and provide a copy to the Elections Office with your Financial Statement - Auditor's Report Form 4
- Complete the Financial Statement - Auditor's Report Form 4; every contributor must be included on the list of contributors, if a Rebate Request form is received for a contributor but the contributor is not listed on the candidate's Financial Statement, a rebate will not be paid
- Submit your Financial Statement - Auditor's Report Form 4 in accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act* along with the Election Office's copy of your Contribution Rebate Request forms for each eligible contribution.
  - Contribution Rebate Request forms that have been issued electronically will automatically upload into the Candidate Information Hub (Portal) and will not have to be submitted in manual copy
  - Contribution Rebate Request forms that have been issued in manual copy must be submitted to the Elections Office via email or in person

To issue a rebate for contributions made on or before December 31, 2022, manual copies of Rebate Request forms must be submitted to the City of Mississauga's Office of the City Clerk, 2nd Floor, Civic Centre, 300 City Centre Drive, Mississauga Ontario, L5B 3C1, or via email at [elections.rebate@mississauga.ca](mailto:elections.rebate@mississauga.ca) no later than 4:30 pm on May 1, 2023. Rebate Request forms that have been issued electronically through the Candidate Information Hub (Portal) will automatically upload and will not need to be emailed, but must be entered into the system no later than 4:30pm on May 1, 2023. If the candidate's campaign period is extended beyond December 31, 2022 because of a deficit, Contribution Rebate Request forms must be submitted no later than 4:30 pm October 30, 2023.

For contributions made during the primary campaign period ending December 31, 2022, rebates will not be issued until AFTER July 3, 2023 and for contributions made after December 31, 2022, rebates will not be issued until AFTER December 29, 2023 to ensure no compliance audit requests are received for the candidate.

In the event that the candidate files the financial statement after the prescribed deadlines as per a court ordered extension or as per section 88.23(9) of the MEA, rebates will be issued later than the above dates.
