

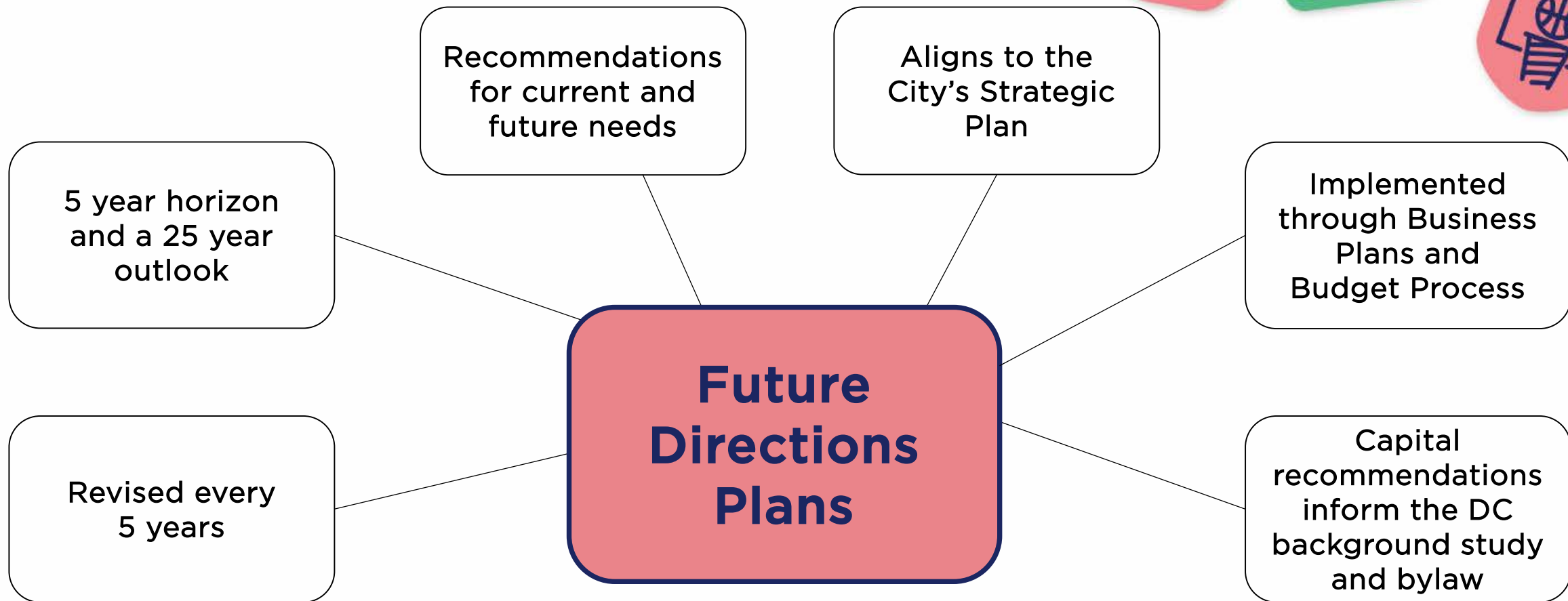

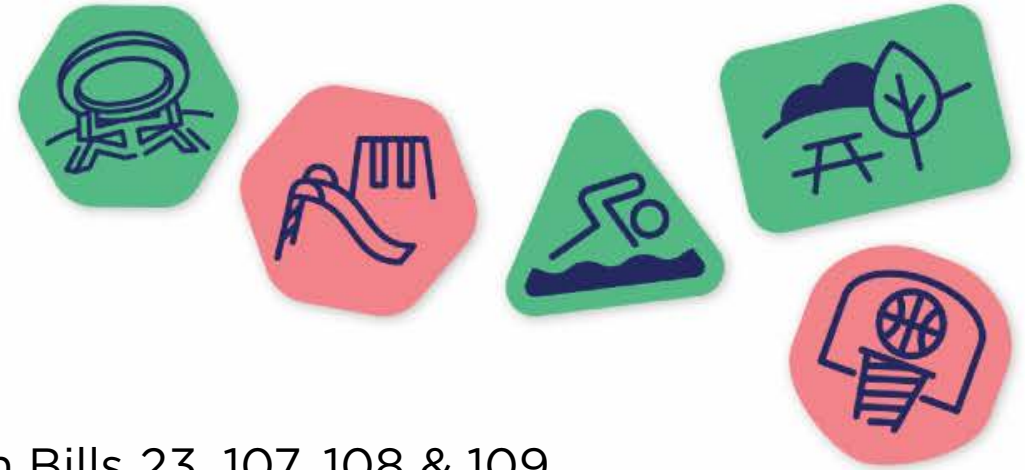


COMMITMENTS & STRATEGIC PRIORITIES
