








1. Aquitaine & Argentia Protected Bike Lanes



Flex-post/bollard protected bike lanes are currently under construction on Aquitaine Avenue and Argentia Road as part of a road safety pilot project. Permanent installations to be determined for 2025/2026 road rehabilitation.

2. Argentia Cycle Tracks & Winston Churchill Trail



New cycle tracks on Argentia Road and a multi-use trail extension on Winston Churchill Boulevard are currently under construction, connecting to existing and under construction bike lanes and a multiuse trail at each end.



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3. Cawthra Multi-Use Trail



A new multi-use trail on the east boulevard of Cawthra Road is under construction. It connects the Eastgate Parkway intersection and Cawthra Transitway station to an existing walkway into the neighborhood.


4. Kennedy Multi-Use Trail



A new multi-use trail is under construction on the east boulevard of Kennedy Road. It connects to bike lanes on Traders Boulevard, and future connections at Britannia Road and Matheson Boulevard.

Kennedy Road Multi-Use Trail Britannia Road East to Matheson Boulevard East (1.3 km)







5. Matheson Cycle Tracks



New cycle tracks are under construction on Matheson Boulevard. They connect to the area bike lane network, and have nearby connections to the Etobicoke Creek Trail, Eglinton Trail, Transitway, and future Eglinton Crosstown LRT extension.

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6. Orr Shared Route



The existing shared route on Orr Road (part of the Waterfront Trail) is being improved with edge lines, sharrows, and speed cushions. New signage and a crossride are being installed at Southdown Road.

7. Winston Churchill Multi-Use Trail




A new multi-use trail is under construction on the west boulevard of Winston Churchill Boulevard. It connects the highway bridge structure to the existing multi-use trail at Unity Drive.

8. Culham-Derry Trail Connection




An off-road trail connecting the Culham Trail, Derry multi-use trail, and Second Line shared route is under construction.

Culham Trail & Derry Road: Trail connection under construction




9. Fowler Cycle Tracks



Cycle tracks on Fowler Drive are finishing construction, along with the reconstruction with the Erin Mills Parkway intersection. The cycle tracks connect the Erin Mills-Southdown Trail to future bike lanes on the remainder of Fowler Drive.
