## **Recommendation**

That the “Streetsville Senior Citizens Centre” be renamed to the “Streetsville Heritage Hall”

## **Background**

In accordance with the City's "Facility Naming" corporate policy, the Community Services Department is directed to bring forth any proposed names of City owned designated heritage buildings to the Heritage Advisory Committee for their consideration prior to a report going to General Committee and Council. In accordance with the policy, General Committee is requested to consider the recommended names brought forth by the Community Services Department for a period of 30 days, after which the Committee is asked to make a final recommendation to Council.

The Streetsville Kinsmen Senior Citizen Centre had been operated by the Streetsville Kinsmen Senior Citizen Centre Inc. group until February 2018 when the group opted not to renew the Management & Operations Agreement with the City. Since that time the Kinsmen have had no connection to this space.

## **Comments**

This Streetsville Kinsmen Senior Citizen Centre is a multi-functional space and is home to the Streetsville Seniors club as well as many family events, parties and meetings. Staff would like to take this opportunity to rename the hall to be more inline with other City run halls (ie. Meadowvale Village Hall, Malton Victory Hall).

The name “Streetsville Village Hall” is already used by the Streetsville BIA so through consultation with community stakeholders the name “Streetsville Heritage Hall” is being recommended. More information can be found in Appendix 1.

Councillor Butt (Ward 11) has been consulted and supports the recommended name.
