- The petition must be appropriate and respectful in tone, and must not contain any improper or offensive language or information.
- Each petitioner must print and sign his or her own name, original signatures only. During the Covid-19 pandemic, electronic or typed signatures will be accepted.
- Each petitioner must provide his or her full address, including property's roll number for a noise wall petition.
- The petition must clearly disclose on each page that it will be considered a public document at the City of Mississauga and that the information contained in it may be subject to the scrutiny of the City and other members of the general public.

The following information outlines the purpose of the petition:

Purpose

- Objecting to Alternative 6 of making Bloor Street a one-way each way street with a center turning lane due to the great traffic concerns that would arise and to cycle tracks being on the boulevard by the curb.
- Objecting to Alternative 5 due to impact it would have to residents who live on Bloor Street, the safety issues associated with this alternative and proposed removal of trees and to cycle tracks being constructed on the boulevard's green space near the sidewalk.

Asking Council For

- Council's agreement, support of and direction to and for City staff to work with the local on Bloor Street and neighbouring area residents who are the key stakeholders to finding another mutually agreeable alternative that will be in the best interest and safety of the residents who live on Bloor Street and neighbouring streets and for everyone in this Bloor Street community in Mississauga as was committed to by the Ward 3 Councillor and city staff at the March 31st, 2022 in-person AHHRA community meeting.
