A By-law to Amend By-law 0078-2018, being the Heritage By-law

WHEREAS sections 8, 9 and 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2007,* S.O. 2001, c. 25 authorize a municipality to pass by-laws necessary or desirable for municipal purposes;

AND WHEREAS the Council for The Corporation of the City of Mississauga adopted Heritage Bylaw No. 0078-2018;

AND WHEREAS the *More Homes More Choice Act, 2019* brought changes to the *Ontario Heritage Act* that include restricting heritage designation timelines once Zoning and/or Official Plan amendment applications are deemed complete;

AND WHEREAS Ontario Regulation 385/21 under the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. O. 18 provides opportunities for Council and an owner of land to agree to extend these timelines or to not apply these timelines;

AND WHEREAS Heritage By-law No. 0078-2018 currently delegates authority to the Director, Culture Division, to agree with an owner of land to extend the timelines for Council to make a decision on applications made under Part IV of the Act;

AND WHEREAS Council is desirous of amending Heritage By-law No. 0078-2018 to include authority for the Director, Culture Division, to agree with an owner of land to waive the restriction on designation timelines as per subsection 1(2) of Regulation 385/21;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 5, subparagraph (4) of By-law 0078-2018 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:
  - (4) **Extensions of Time:** agree to the extension or waive the restriction of any time limit within which Council must make a decision on an application or provide notice under the Act, provided that the Owner agrees to the extension or waiver; and
