


## **Dundas BRT Mississauga East Project**

- Detail Design and Early Works: 2025
- Construction commencement: 2026




Typical Dundas BRT roadway configuration from Camilla Road/Kirwin Avenue to Etobicoke Creek

- Creating a complete street for all users





- Property constraint (building impact) makes this vision financially unviable






### **Downtown Cooksville Current Condition**

# **Downtown Cookville Limited Space for Streetscape Improvements**






## Downtown Cooksville Proposed Interim Design

#### Roadway

- 2 BRT lanes
- 2 general purpose lanes
- Left and right turn restrictions

#### **Boulevard:**

- Pole / Furniture Zone
  - 0.6 2m
- Sidewalk
  - 1.5 2m
- Cycling Track
  - 1.5 2m



## Downtown Cooksville Proposed Interim Design


#### **Benefits:**

## **Next Steps**

- A note to file to the TPAP is required in order for the proposed work to proceed.
- Staff are seeking endorsement of the interim design and the authority to file a TPAP note to file. The TPAP note to file memo will enable the interim design to be implemented as part of the Dundas BRT Mississauga East Project.
- After the TPAP note to file process is completed, staff and the technical advisor will work together to finalize the Reference Concept Design (RCD) and Project Specific Output Specification (PSOS).
- The RCD and PSOS will be incorporated into the RFP package of the Dundas BRT Mississauga East Project, which is anticipated to be issued in Q1 2024.
