A by-law to amend the Road Occupancy Permit By-law 0173-2020 to amend Road Occupancy Deposits in Schedule "A"

WHEREAS Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga ("Council") has enacted By-law 0173-2020, being the Road Occupancy Permit By-law;

AND WHEREAS sections 8, 9 and 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* authorize a municipality to pass by-laws necessary or desirable for municipal purposes;

AND WHEREAS Council considers it desirable and necessary to amend Road Occupancy Deposits, as set out in the corporate report from the Commissioner of Transportation and Works, adopted by Council on October 11, 2023 and entitled "2024 Road Occupancy, Lot Grading and Municipal Services Protection Deposits Update";

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That Schedule "A" to By-law 0173-2020, as amended, be deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Schedule "A" attached as Appendix 1 attached to this By-law.
- 2. This By-law shall come into force on January 1, 2024.

**Road Occupancy Permit - Maintenance/Restoration Deposit:

The City of Mississauga will undertake all permanent restoration works within 24 months after the Applicant's work has been completed. Actual costs incurred to carry out final restoration work plus 25% administration charge plus Road Degradation Fee (see current Transportation and Works Fees and Charges By-law) will be deducted from the deposit and the balance will be refunded back to the Applicant. For those locations where the deposit is not sufficient the Applicant will be invoiced.
