Subject: Environmental Action Committee Progress on 2023-2026 Work Plan

(Reporting period May to December 2023)

Background:

At the December 5, 2023 Environmental Action Committee (EAC) meeting, EAC Members agreed to report on progress on EAC's work plan (2023-2026) through a memorandum to Mayor and Members of Council via email.

Comments:

The new term (2023-2026) of EAC began on May 16, 2023. A refreshed work plan and supporting actions need to be developed in coordination with the newly elected EAC Members and the City's Environment staff. City staff organized work planning sessions on July 19, 2023 (in-person) and on August 22, 2023 (online). A summary of what EAC Members shared and identified as items that are of interest are as follows:

- Effective ways to take action
- City and external initiatives including scope of Environment team & other related City departments
- Learn from other EAC Members and experts outside of EAC
- Understanding mid-range climate change targets
- Learning about new innovations to achieve climate goals
- Quantifiable community engagement on climate action
- Clear climate communications & education

EAC Members also expressed a desire to have increased feedback regarding EAC related matters approved by Council. Approved recommendation reports will be provided to members by email.
