### **Community Rides**


#### **Enhancements:**

- Professionalize booth
- New pop-up tent
- Additional signage, advertising
- Co-branding with Mississauga50, other elements
- Est budget \$15,000 (note sponsorship from Toronto Pearson \$8,000)



### Bike Challenge

- Partner with Forestry
- Tree Plantings
- Funding for software development
- Advertising
- Coordinate with Community Rides
- Est budget \$15,000



#### **Bike Festival**

- New concept
- Spring event, launch cycling season



- Large-scale event, multiple vendors and activities
- Advertising, logistics
- Est budget \$20,000 (including budget for hiring Event Planning support)

# **Community Group Support**

- Considering how to better support external community groups who are already delivering cycling programming in Mississauga
- Regional Dissolution is in the background
- Program delivery will evolve and change




Figure 13: Many local organizations will have program objectives that could be met through cycling. Spread the net wide, and then a in For Scarborough Cycles, we started with a long list of nine potential partners and did detailed analysis for the four that looked mos

- Specialized staffing support to plan and deliver Event Planning professionals
