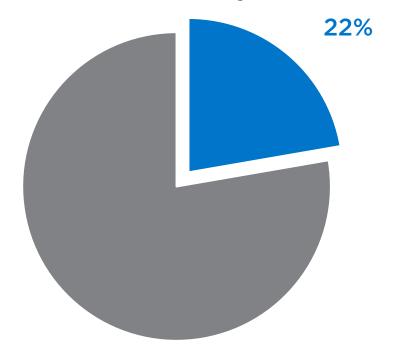

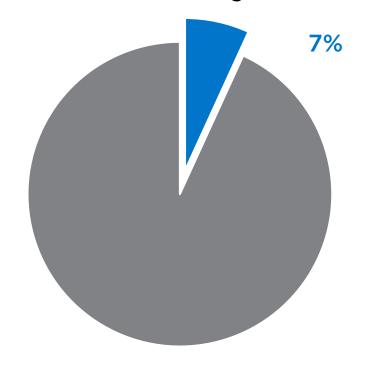

% of City

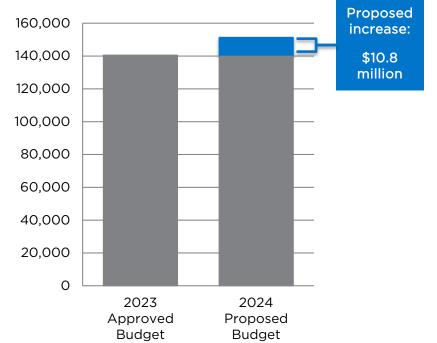

% of City



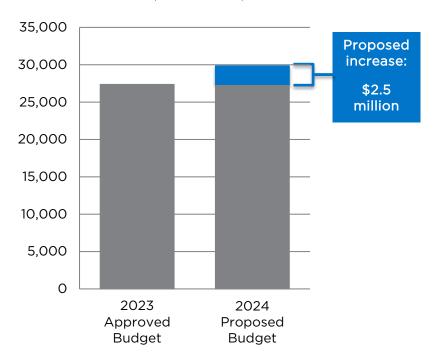
2024 Net Operating Budget

- Invest in the training of emergency services staff



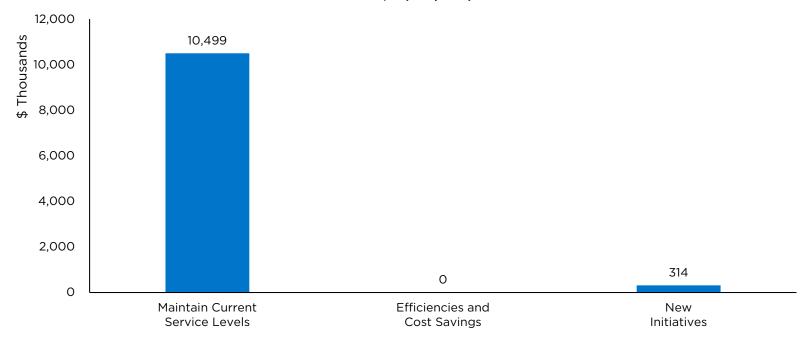

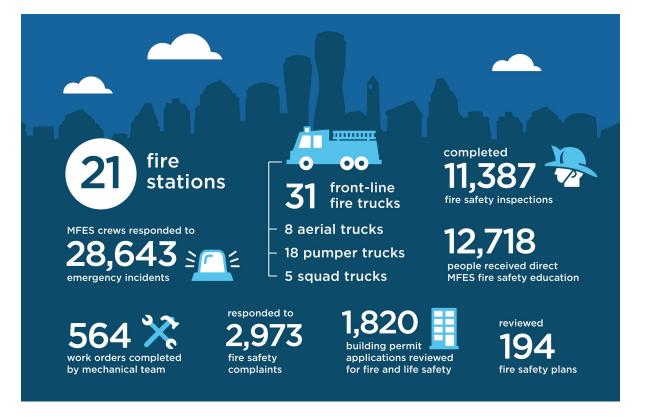

10-Year Capital Plan

2024-2033 projects are proposed to be funded at \$369 million and include:

- New fire station infrastructure
- Fire station renovations
- Personal protective equipment replacement
- Lifecycle replacement of Fire vehicles
- Lifecycle replacement of front-line operating equipment
