Subject: **Resignation of former Mayor, Bonnie Crombie**

Attached is the resignation letter of former City of Mississauga Mayor, Bonnie Crombie. The resignation was effective as of January 12, 2024. In accordance to section 262(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, Council must declare the seat vacant at their next Council meeting, which will be held on January 17, 2024.

To that end, it is recommended that Council receive the attached Notice of Resignation and declare the seat of the City of Mississauga's head of Council vacant.

Under section 226.10 (1) of the *Strong Mayors and Building Homes Act, 2022*, a vacancy for the head of council must be filled by by-election. Following the declaration of the vacancy on January 17, 2024, staff will present a Corporate Report at the January 31, 2024 Council meeting regarding the timing of the by-election. When determining the timing, staff will weigh the need to fill the vacant seat with the administrative and technical requirements associated with a City-wide by-election.
