

Thank you for the link. I will respond to some of the concerns that were raised.

Coplogic is the program that we use for *all* of the on-line reports, not online Road Watch. The report has all possible fields that may be required depending on the type of report that is submitted. Users are required to enter the mandatory fields as indicated by the red * . Therefore, all other fields are not required to be filled out.

Residence can attend our webpage to educate themselves on campaigns such as ERASE etc...

Take the Pledge Peel campaign has been dormant for awhile now. I will reach out to my new Inspector and discuss.

Regarding possible creating a three digit number ie: 311 is not likely as these cases are not urgent, and do not require immediate action. Our current process using the online reporting system is appropriate, as it allows the complainant to enter the information and does not require the officer to call back. Leaving the officer (me) time spent on prioritizing and requesting studies via the City Transportation departments. None of the reports that are submitted are urgent, as it indicates in the pre-questions, if the incident were deemed urgent, the caller would be directed to call 911.

I like the idea of creating a QR code on your City signs that would link the report.

Regarding the dash-cam footage, they are submitted within the report already via a link in the narrative, also photos can be attached to the report.
