Subject: Request to Alter a Heritage Designated Property at: 52 Front Street

South (Ward 1)

Background:

The subject property located at 52 Front Street South (Ward 1)is designated under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act* as it forms part of the Old Port Credit Village Heritage Conservation District (HCD). It is considered a contributing property. Changes to the property are subject to the Old Port Credit Village HCD Plan, 2018.

Comments:

On December 6, 2022 the Heritage Advisory Committee approved the construction of a new dwelling at 52 Front Street South. The recommendation for this property can be found in the December 6th minutes located in the following link: <u>HAC Minutes December 6th</u>.

Through conversations with the City of Mississauga's Planning Department the property owner have made two changes to their approved plans. The master bedroom located on the south-side of the building on the second floor will be reduced by 18 square meters. Two windows on the rear facing side will be removed. For the further details, see Appendix 1. Both of these changes are minor and will not impact the character of the Old Port Credit Heritage Conservation District.
