## What is the Housing Accelerator Fund (HAF)?

Federal funding program for local / single tier municipalities



- Focus: increase housing supply through systemic changes
- Mississauga receiving \$112.9M over 4 installments
- Commitment consists of Action Plan and Targets
  - Residential building permit target of ~1,000 units per year above-and-beyond average building permit issuances of ~3,500 units per year
  - Also includes other growth and affordable housing targets





### **Action Plan**

- 1. Incentivize affordable rental housing
- 2. Expand as-of-right permissions in residential neighbourhoods
- 3. Accelerate housing through system improvements & case management of development applications
- 4. Unlock growth through strategic investments in transit and multi-modal oriented development



The actions stem from Growing Mississauga



#4 - Infrastructure that supports housing growth



## **Action Plan**

- 5. Partner with Region / Peel Housing Corporation to build housing for households in need
- 6. Convert employment lands and implement mixeduse zoning where appropriate
- 7. Identify opportunities for multi-unit residential permissions on key sites
- 8. Optimize government land for affordable housing

## Infrastructure to unlock housing growth

- Action 4: Unlock growth through strategic investments in transit and multi-modal oriented development
- In its HAF application, the City identified upcoming cycling infrastructure to be added to higher growth corridors within the HAF timeframe
  - Building new cycling infrastructure will support new housing units in these areas
- Identified cycling infrastructure that is already in our short-term plan & is consistent with Cycling Master Plan



# Spending the HAF Funding

- HAF targets are measured in terms of new housing units, and the final installment of funding is dependent on the City hitting housing targets
- There are no cycling infrastructure targets
- Some HAF funding could offset cost of installing cycling infrastructure
