

A by-law to provide for a by-election for  
the Office of Mayor for the City of  
Mississauga

**WHEREAS** on January 17, 2024, a vacancy was declared for the office of Mayor pursuant to section 262 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (the “*Municipal Act, 2001*”);

**AND WHEREAS** subsection 263(1)(b) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that if a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of council, the municipality shall require a by-election to be held to fill the vacancy in accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, S.O. 1996, c. 32, Sched.;

**AND WHEREAS** subsection 263(5)1.ii. of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that within 60 days after the day a declaration of vacancy is made with respect to the vacancy under section 262, the municipality shall, pass a by-law requiring a by-election be held to fill the vacancy under subsection 263(1);

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga hereby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That a by-election shall be held to fill the vacancy for the office of Mayor.
