Background

The Mississauga Apartment Rental Compliance (MARC) 5-year pilot program ensures rental apartment buildings are well-maintained to support safe, secure and livable communities through:

- Mandatory annual registration
- Enhanced owner responsibilities
- Proactive inspections
- Education & awareness

The program scope includes:

- 356 apartment buildings
- Buildings that contain at least two storeys, six units and a shared common area



Program Results

The success of the program is being assessed through registration compliance, building evaluation and audit results, compliance with by-law requirements and tenant engagement.


