## **Project Overview**

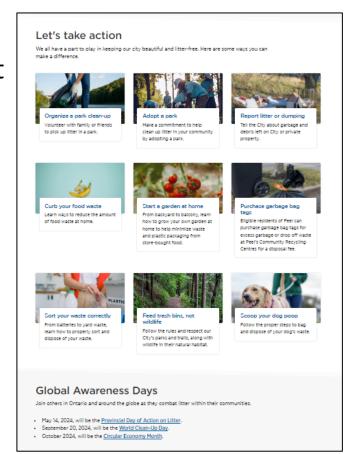
- Reduce litter in parks, trails, roadways and open spaces

  - Amplify waste reduction messaging to include single-use items



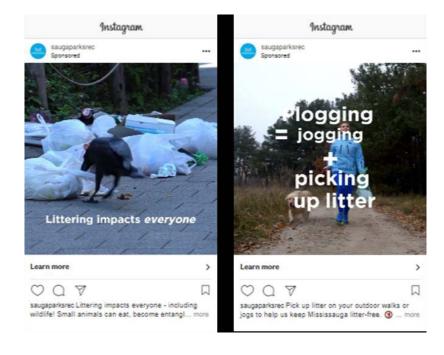


## **Digital Advertisements**

- Litter and waste-related 311 calls down 15% and 10% in 2022 & 2023, respectively
