



On-Road Cycling Master Plan Network Progress




1. Argentia Protected Bike Lanes



Flex-post/bollard protected bike lanes have been constructed on Argentia Road as part of a road safety pilot project. Permanent installations to be determined for a 2025 road rehabilitation.

Intersection east of Winston Churchill Boulevard to Derry Road West (2.2 km)





2. Collegeway Cycle Tracks



New cycle tracks are under construction on The Collegeway. They will connect to the South Common Centre, Winston Churchill Trail, Erin Mills Trail, South Millway Bike Lanes, and future cycling infrastructure on Glen Erin Drive.

The Collegeway Cycle Tracks


Winston Churchill Boulevard to South Millway (east) (2.2 km)







3. Goreway Multi-Use Trail



A new multi-use trail is under construction on Goreway Drive, as part of the Goreway Drive Grade Separation Project. It will connect to Brampton, the Malton Loop bicycle route, and future cycling infrastructure on Goreway Drive to the south.

Brampton border to Brandon Gate Drive (0.3 km)






4. Rathburn-Ponytrail Cycle Tracks



New cycle tracks are under construction on Rathburn Road East and Ponytrail Drive. They will connect to the Dixie Trail, Burnhamthorpe Trail, Etobicoke Creek Trail, and the hydro corridor trail.

(2.8 km)








5. Winston Churchill Multi-Use Trail



A new multi-use trail on the west boulevard of Winston Churchill Boulevard has been constructed. It will connect the highway bridge structure to the existing multi-use trail at Unity Drive.



- 12. Creditview Road Multi-use trail: Financial Drive to Old Creditview Road (0.4 km)
- 13. Eglinton Avenue West Multi-use trail: Erin Mills Parkway to Credit Valley Road/Summersky Court (0.5 km)
- 14. Explorer Drive Bicycle lanes: Skymark Avenue to Eglinton Avenue West (0.2 km)
- 15. Mississauga Road Bicycle lanes: Eglinton Ave West to Bridlepath Trail (1.5 km)
