Subject

Request to Alter the Heritage Designated property at 1507 Cawthra Road (Ward 1)

Recommendation

That the request to alter the heritage designated property at 1507 Cawthra Road (Ward 1), as per the Corporate Report from the Commissioner of Community Services, dated April 10, 2024 be approved.

Executive Summary

- Alterations to designated property require Council approval in consultation with the City's Heritage Advisory Committee.
- The City's Facilities Maintenance team proposes to install clear polycarbonate on the exterior of the windows and side lites at the subject property to protect them from vandalism.
- The proposal is sympathetic and beneficial; it should be approved.

Background

The City designated the subject property in 1992. As per section 33 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, requests to alter heritage designated property require approval from Council in consultation with the City's Heritage Advisory Committee.

Comments

The City's Facilities Maintenance team proposes to affix clear window coverings on the face of the windows and side lites at the subject property to prevent breakage due to vandalism. 10 mm polycarbonate would be screwed into the wood trim with painted wood trim on the exterior. The

application is attached as Appendix 1. The proposal will not negatively impact the heritage character of the property; it will protect it. Therefore, the proposal should be approved.

Financial Impact

There is no financial impact resulting from the recommendation of this report.

Conclusion

Facilities Maintenance proposes to sensitively affix clear window covers to the glass windows and side lites at the subject property to protect these elements. The proposal should be approved.
