Summary:

BikeFest launched this year's cycling season in Mississauga.

As part of Mississauga's 50th anniversary, the City hosted BikeFest on Saturday, May 11 at Mississauga Celebration Square from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. This was a free community event with fun and interactive cycling activities for all ages.

The event attracted nearly 1000 attendees of all ages. Some highlights from Bikefest included:


