Grant Programs: Purpose




Grants assist emerging and established community-based groups and organizations:

- Support their operations;
- Deliver programs or services;
- Complete special projects that address needs in the community;
- Contribute to advancing the City's 2024 Future Directions Culture Plan.



Grants Process





Culture Grant Programs

Arts & Culture Grants

- Provides funding to cultural organizations to offset the cost of their operating expenses
- Annual and three-year multiyear grants
- Maximum Annual Funding: \$120,000 or 50% of total operating budget.
- Maximum Multi-Year Funding: 65% of total operating budget.

<u>Cultural Festivals and Celebrations</u> **Grants**

- Provides funding to offset the eligible expenses associated with cultural festivals/celebrations.
- Annual and three-year multiyear grants
- Maximum Funding: \$120,000 or 30% of total operating budget.

Culture Projects

- Provides funding to support a specific arts and culture initiative.
- Each year the Culture Projects grant has a theme that helps to advance City priorities (2024, 'Celebrate 50')
- Maximum Funding: \$5000



Volunteer Peer Assessment Committee

- Open call for peer assessors.
- Peer Assessors approved by Council for a four-year term.
- Eligibility: Practicing arts and culture professional for two years, or a community member with a background in the arts sector/community support.
- Peer Assessors must declare conflicts of interest with applicants.






2024 Grant Allocations





2024 Culture Grant Results and Observations








Current State of Grants Budget

- 2024 Culture Grants Budget= \$3,520,500.
- \$2,481,750 contributed by the MAT.
- \$1,038,750 contributed through the Recreation & Culture operating budget.
- 72% increase in grant applications between 2019-2024.
