





1. Collegeway Cycle Tracks



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
2. Cardiff Multi-Use Trail




3. Creditview Multi-Use Trail


Creditview Road Multi-Use Trail Financial Drive to Old Creditview Road (0.4 km)

4. Eglinton Multi-Use Trail




A new multi-use trail is under construction on Eglinton Avenue West. It fills a gap between two existing trail sections.



6. Rathburn-Ponytrail Cycle Tracks








