Which is the following:

The creek behind our property along Pacific Circle, better known to the City as REACH ETOB-2300 has been grossly neglected by the City. As a result weeds have completely filled in this waterway, and beavers have built dams on several occasions.

On the day of the weather event, the waterway backed up in front of one of those beaver dams, leading to a flood that affected the businesses on 7125 Pacific Circle.

We have 5 industrial units there, and 2 of them were completely flooded inside. [REDACTED]

This was a clear case of gross negligence on the part of the City. The weeds should have been removed as a matter of annual maintenance.
