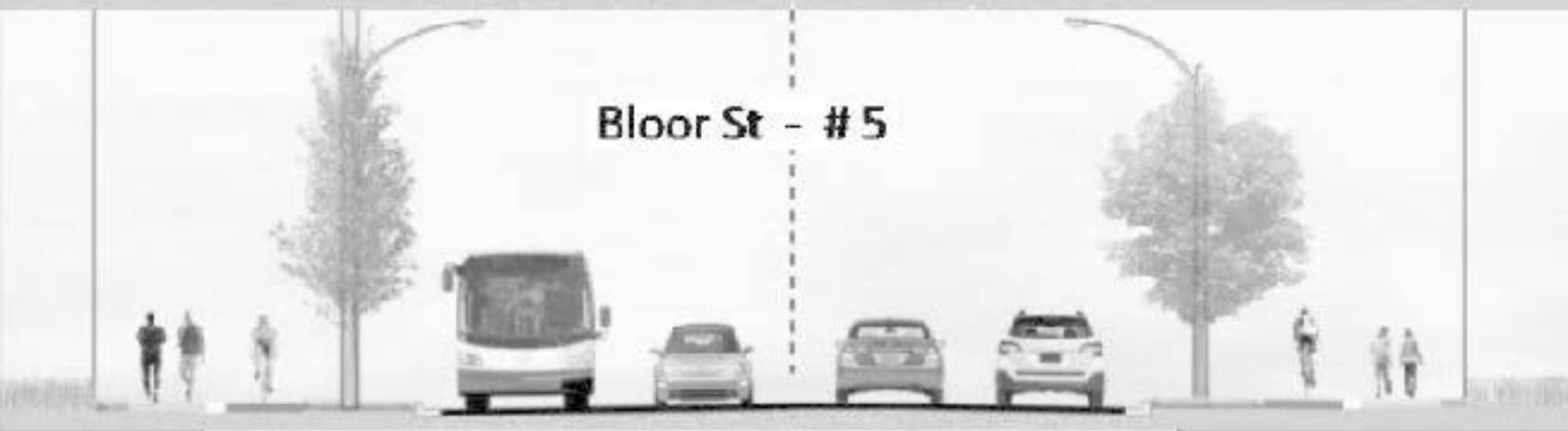




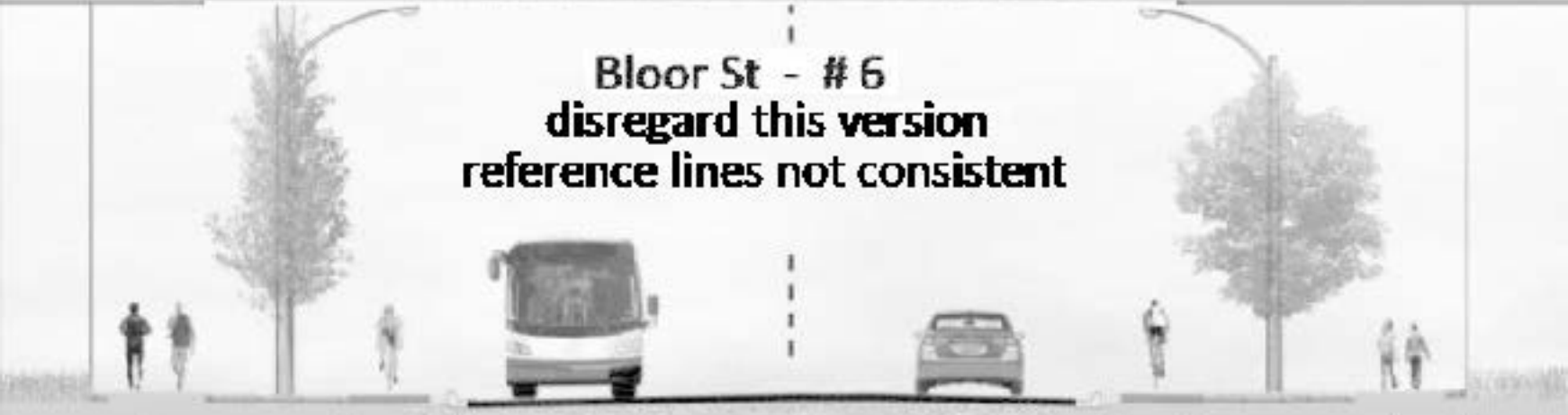
Bloor St - Existing



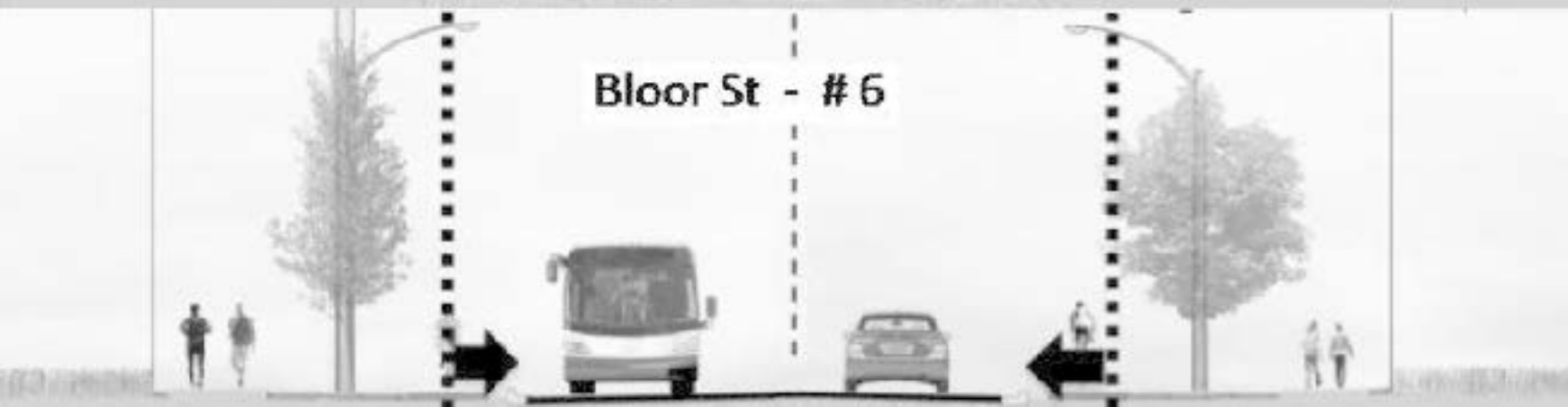
