# **Education Program Fee Notes - Culture**

#### STANDARD DISCOUNTS

Children 3 years of age and under: Free (Museums of Mississauga ONLY)

## **DEFINITIONS**

Family: Maximum of 5 people, including up to 2 adults

Child: 4 - 12 years of age
Student: 13 - 17 years of age
Adult: 18 years of age and over
Older Adult: 55 years of age and over
SHSM: Specialist High Skills Major

## **GENERAL NOTES**

- 1. Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) does not apply to children and youth 14 years and under and persons with disability with exception of museum overnight programs.
- 2. Educational Programs with a curriculum connection being delivered to schools are exempt from Harmonized Sales Tax (HST).
- 3. Corporate Policy 04-01-02 governs requirements related to the administration of fees, including methods of payment, payment terms and conditions, transfers and withdrawals.
- 4. Where program fee structure aligns to Recreation, the Recreation Fees & Charges Schedule for programs is used.
- 5. From time to time, the Director of Recreation and Culture may approve a new fee, waive a fee, approve promotional pricing and/or discounts on any Culture fee in accordance with the general criteria for any such waiver, reduction or variation.
- 6. Payment terms and conditions can be found within Corporate Policy 04-01-02.

#### **CULTURE EDUCATION PROGRAMS**

- 1. There will be one complimentary ticket for every 10 purchased for LAC School Performances. Everyone entering the theatre must have a ticket.
- 2. For school outreach workshops, if distance travelled is over 30 km from the LAC, additional mileage fee of \$0.59 per km is applied.

The total km travelled includes the travel to and from the LAC.

- 3. Additional fee may be applied for School Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) Events for Keynote speaker. This fee fluctuates based on performer and is charged back to the school board for the full fee for the performance.
- 4. School workshops booked for Grades JK-3 will have a minimum charge equal to 18 participants. School workshops booked for Grades 4 and above will have a minimum charge equal to 20 participants.
- 5. Adults/teachers will be free of charge when accompanying a school group for a School Workshop Program.
- 6. There is a minimum of 2 workshops required for School Outreach Workshop bookings. School Outreach workshops booked for Grades JK-3 will have a maximum of 30 participants per workshop. School Outreach workshops booked for Grades 4 and above will have a maximum of 40 participants per workshop.
- 7. Virtual school workshops minimum charge of 18 participants and max participant of 30.

### MUSEUMS OF MISSISSAUGA

- 1. Adults/teachers, up to a maximum of 6, will be free of charge when accompanying a school group for an Education Program. Additional adults/teachers will be charged the participant rate plus applicable taxes.
- 2. Education, evening and overnight programs have a minimum charge equal to 14 participants.
- 3. Two adults will be free of charge for the first 14 participants for museum overnight programs; additional adult charge applies thereafter.
- 4. Use of Support Person If a visitor with a disability is assisted by a support person, the support person will be admitted to Museum Programs free of charge. Corporate Policy 03-08-05 shall govern the requirements related to support persons.
