6.1 David Ecclestone, Architect, +VG Architects and Deryn Rizzi, Chief, Mississauga Fire & Emergency Services regarding Lakeview Golf Course Land Parcel Severance and Heritage Impact Assessment

Chief Deryn Rizzi, Mississauga Fire and Emergency Services spoke to the Community Risk Assessment recommendations and creation of the Master Fire Plan, the review of the Master Fire Plan standards, the process of selecting locations for five new fire stations and emergency response times. Further, Chief Rizzi spoke to the Lakeview development location for Fire Station 128 and the area it would service.
